- **4. GRANTS** Consider/Approve/Take Action, Adopt Resolutions on Projects, Professional Services, Awards, Authorize Bidding/Purchases, Projects in Progress, Applications, Future Projects, Resolutions, Contracts, Payment of Invoices, Fund Distribution and/or additional Public Hearings.
 - **a. CDBG-MIT HERON SLOUGH** Review/Approve/Take Action to adopt a resolution supporting Calhoun County's application for drainage project along Highway 185 outside the City and inside the City where that drainage project is referred to as the Heron Slough MIT Grant Project.
 - **b. CDBG-MIT DRAINAGE** Review/Consider/Approve/Take action on approving a hiring resolution for Lynn Engineering to assist in the completion of application(s) and with funding, project implementation including design and construction oversight for the CDBG-MIT, to include Hurricane Harvey State Mitigation Competition, Method of Distribution and Supplemental Funding and authorize the Mayor to complete negotiations with selected firm and sign a contract(s). *Note: Lynn Engineering was awarded in the August 4, 2020, Regular Meeting.*
 - c. FEMA-PA Project 3224 Harbor Debris: Review/Consider/Approve change order to TFR contract cost.

- **d. FEMA-PA Project 3228 Seawall:** Review/Consider/Approve/Take Action to pay engineer invoice for \$222,000. *Note: FEMA-PA will pay 90% (\$199,800) and GLO will pay 10% (\$22,200).*
- e. FEMA-PA Project 18367 12 to 15 Shoreline: Review/Consider/Approve/Take Action to pay engineer invoice for \$19,650. Note: FEMA-PA will pay 90% (\$17,685) and GLO will pay 10% (\$1,965).
- **f. FEMA-PA Project 10633 Bayfront Park Restroom: –** Review/Consider/Approve/Take Action to pay engineer invoice of \$9,750. *Note: FEMA-PA will pay 90% (\$8,775) and GLO will pay 10% (\$975).*
- **g. FEMA-PA Project 9438 Harbor Moorings/Jetty:** Review/Consider/Approve/Take Action to pay engineer invoice for \$15,300. *Note: FEMA-PA will pay 90% (\$13,770) and GLO will pay 10% (\$1,530).*

Note: The City will be reviewing several possible projects, primarily water/sewer, with an eye towards a facility located in the west side of City to boost water pressure, city-wide.
