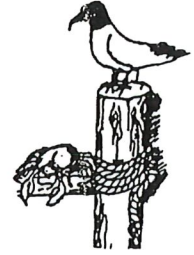

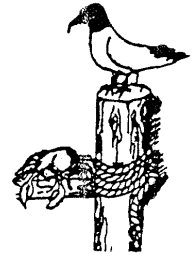

The total amount awarded was \$60,854.48 with no match requirements. The Seadrift Police Department would use these funds to purchase a new unit to replace the 2017 Tahoe that was made surplus by City Council at a previous meeting. The Police Department received a quote from Silsbee Fleet for a 2024 Pursuit Model Dodge Durango for \$66,251.23.

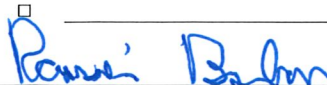

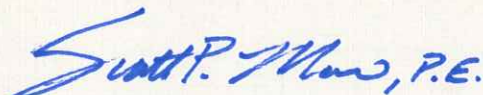
