I. THE YINON PLAN: WHAT IT SAYS AND WHAT IT MEANS

The document Oded Yinon published in February 1982 in *Kivunim* — the journal of the World Zionist Organization — is not a theory, a rumor, or an antisemitic forgery. It is a primary source strategic document, translated by Israeli Professor Israel Shahak, a Holocaust survivor, founder of the Israeli League for Human and Civil Rights, and Professor of Organic Chemistry at Hebrew University Jerusalem.

The plan operates on two foundational premises: (1) Israel must become an imperial regional power. (2) Israel must effect the dissolution of all existing Arab states into small, ethnically or religiously defined statelets that become Israel’s satellites.

These are not Shahak’s words. This is Yinon’s documented vision, printed in the WZO’s own official journal. Shahak’s introduction states plainly: *“The plan follows faithfully the geopolitical ideas current in Germany of 1890–1933, which were swallowed whole by Hitler and the Nazi movement, and determined their aims for East Europe.”*

II. BY WAY OF DECEPTION: THE OPERATIONAL DOCTRINE

Victor Ostrovsky's 1990 insider account, *By Way of Deception*, provides the operational architecture that executes the Yinon strategic vision. The Israeli government attempted to suppress the book through Canadian courts before its publication. That attempt failed. The book stands as one of the most detailed first-person accounts of Mossad doctrine ever published by an insider.

THE MOTTO

On the first day of Mossad Academy training, head of the Academy Aharon Sherf addressed the new class:

*“My name is Aharon Sherf. I am the head of the Academy. Welcome to the Mossad. Its full name is Ha Mossad, le Modiyn ye le Talkidim Mayubadim [the Institute for Intelligence and Special Operations]. Our motto is: ‘By way of deception, thou shalt do war.’” — Victor Ostrovsky, *By Way of Deception*, p. 53*

This motto — drawn from a corrupted reading of Mishlei (Proverbs) 24:6 — is not incidental. It is the organizational identity of Israel’s premier intelligence agency, stated openly to every incoming class of katsas. Deception is not a tool. It is the doctrine.

THE SAYANIM NETWORK

One of Ostrovsky's most significant disclosures is the sayanim system — a global network of Jewish volunteers outside Israel who provide operational support to the Mossad without pay, out of loyalty to the cause.

Ostrovsky documents: In London alone, approximately 2,000 active sayanim and 5,000 on reserve. Car sayanim provide rental vehicles without documentation. Apartment sayanim provide safe houses without records. Bank sayanim provide cash at any hour. Doctor sayanim treat bullet wounds without police reports. Business sayanim can produce millions in inventory overnight as operational cover.

“You have at your disposal a nonrisk recruitment system that actually gives you a pool of millions of Jewish people to tap from outside your own borders... One thing you know for sure is that even if a Jewish person knows it is the Mossad, he might not agree to work with you — but he won’t turn you in.” — Ostrovsky, p. 88

This is the operational engine that allows the Mossad to project global reach with only 30–35 field officers (katsas) deployed worldwide at any given time — compared to the CIA’s 25,000 employees and the KGB’s 250,000+. The sayanim multiply force by embedding the Mossad invisibly inside the Jewish diaspora.

MOSSAD UNACCOUNTABLE: OUT OF CONTROL

Ostrovsky's core indictment is not of Jewish people — it is of an intelligence organization that operates without democratic accountability, manipulating even its own government:

“What the Mossad is doing, then, because it is not accountable to anyone, is not just hurting the Institute, but hurting Israel. Israel could be the greatest country in the world, but the Mossad is destroying it by manipulating power, not in the best interests of Israel, but in its own best interests.” — Ostrovsky, p. 216

This aligns precisely with what Israel Shahak states in his introduction to the Yinon Plan: that the Mossad manipulates the prime minister into "approving or taking actions that may be in the best interest of those running the Mossad, but not necessarily in the best interests of Israel." Two witnesses. One indictment.

SABRA AND SHATILA: MOSSAD'S LEBANON ARCHITECTURE

The Beirut chapter of *By Way of Deception* provides the most detailed inside account of how the 1982 Sabra and Shatila massacre unfolded — and who knew what, when.

Ostrovsky documents that the Mossad cultivated Bashir Gemayel and the Lebanese Christian Phalangists for years as proxy forces inside Lebanon. After Gemayel was assassinated by Syrian intelligence on September 14, 1982, Phalangist commander Elias Hobeika — a Mossad contact who had attended the Israeli Staff and Command College — led his forces into the Sabra and Shatila camps.

"The next day, Hobeika received Israeli permission to bring two additional battalions into the camps. Israel knew the massacre was taking place. Israeli forces had even set up observation posts on top of several seven-story buildings at the Kuwaiti embassy traffic circle, giving them an unobstructed view of the carnage." — Ostrovsky, p. 320

800 Palestinian civilians — men, women, children — were killed. This is not ancient history. It is the documented operational template for proxy violence behind which the initiating power maintains plausible deniability. The Mossad taught Hobeika. The IDF fired the illumination flares. The killing was done by Lebanese hands.

The covenant standard from **Bemidbar (Numbers) 35:33** applies: *"for blood pollutes the land, and no expiation can be made for the land for the blood that is shed in it, except by the blood*

of him who shed it.” Indirect complicity in **dam naki** — innocent blood — is still a covenant violation.

III. THE GREATER ISRAEL PROJECT: CURRENT STATUS (2024–2026)

What was Yinon’s 1982 strategic vision is now 2025–2026 Israeli government policy, documented by the United Nations, the International Court of Justice, Amnesty International, and the International Crisis Group.

THE IDEOLOGICAL CLAIM: FROM HERZL TO THE KNESSET

The foundational territorial claim appears in the Yinon document itself: Theodore Herzl wrote in his *Complete Diaries* (Vol. II, p. 711) that the Jewish state stretches “from the Brook of Egypt to the Euphrates.” Rabbi Fischmann testified before the UN Special Committee on July 9, 1947: “The Promised Land extends from the River of Egypt up to the Euphrates, it includes parts of Syria and Lebanon.”

In July 2025, this ideological claim became Knesset action. The UN Special Committee to Investigate Israeli Practices reported that the Knesset adopted a motion calling for annexation of the entire West Bank, declaring it “an inseparable part of the Land of Israel.” The Israeli Defense Minister announced that forces would remain indefinitely in parts of Gaza, Lebanon, and Syria under the justification of “security zones.”

SYRIA AND LEBANON: THE BUFFER ZONES

Following the collapse of Assad in December 2024, Israel moved immediately. Beyond the previously occupied Golan Heights, Israeli forces advanced into the UN buffer zone, adding 235 square kilometers of Syrian territory. At least nine Israeli military bases — seven inside the buffer zone and two beyond — signal long-term presence. Settler movement *Ori Tzafon* ("Go North") has published maps of 300 planned settlements in southern Lebanon with Arabic names replaced by biblical Hebrew names.

In Lebanon, despite a ceasefire announced November 27, 2024, Israeli forces have not withdrawn from five strategic hills overlooking northern Israel: al-Hammams, al-Oweidah, al-Aziyah, Jabal Blat, and al-Labouneh. On April 8, 2026, Operation Eternal Darkness struck 100 Hezbollah targets in 10 minutes — the largest single aerial assault since the 2024 pager explosions. Civilian casualties were documented at a funeral in Shmestar, in Sidon, in western Beirut, and among three girls in Adloun.

IV. THE USA/ISRAEL/IRAN WAR: A COVENANT TIMELINE

June 13–24, 2025	The Twelve-Day War: Israel strikes Iranian nuclear and military facilities in surprise attack. US intercepts Iranian retaliation and bombs three Iranian nuclear sites on June 22. Ceasefire brokered by Oman on June 24. Iran's air defenses significantly degraded.

The stated justifications for the war have shifted repeatedly. The Trump administration offered multiple rationales: to forestall Iranian retaliation after an expected Israeli attack, to stop an imminent Iranian threat, to destroy Iran’s missile capabilities, to prevent nuclear weapons development, to seize Iranian oil resources, and to achieve regime change. The International Atomic Energy Agency stated that while Iran has an ambitious nuclear program and has refused inspections of damaged sites, there was no evidence of an ongoing nuclear weapons program prior to the strikes.

V. THE COVENANT STANDARD: WHAT THE TANAKH SAYS

This is the irreplaceable witness of Miqdash Bethel Covenant Assembly. Every political analysis above must be measured against the unchanging standard of Yahweh’s covenant law. Four covenant principles govern this entire crisis:

I. DAM NAKI — INNOCENT BLOOD

The Tanakh establishes in **Bemidbar (Numbers) 35:33** and **Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:10** that innocent blood defiles the land itself. **"For blood pollutes the land, and no expiation can be made for the land for the blood that is shed in it."** This is not a New Testament principle. It is not Islamic law. It is **Yahweh’s** foundational covenant standard, given to Moshe (Moses) at Sinai, binding on every government that claims covenant identity.

The documented civilian deaths in Gaza (70,000+ by October 2025 ceasefire), Lebanon (2,000+ in 2026 Lebanon war), and Iran (thousands documented across 26 provinces) constitute *dam naki* under any lexically honest reading of the Hebrew text. Yinon's own plan explicitly calls for "*mass humiliation or bombardment and obliteration of cities*" as the enforcement mechanism for the mini-state network. That is a confession, not a policy paper.

2. GVULOT — COVENANT BOUNDARIES

Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:14 and Mishlei (Proverbs) 22:28: "You shall not move your neighbor's boundary marker." The Torah given at Sinai does not authorize modern military conquest as covenant fulfillment. The Herzl/Fischmann territorial claim from the Nile to the Euphrates is a *midrashic* reading of the Abrahamic promise applied as colonial real estate law. The Torah does not authorize human armies to execute this in the post-Sinai age by conquest of existing peoples.

The ICJ advisory opinion of July 2024 found Israel's occupation, settlement activity, and annexation measures illegal under international law. The covenant standard goes further: **Yahweh's** own law forbids the removal of boundary markers, the theft of land (Vayikra/Leviticus 19:13), and the oppression of the stranger (Shemot/Exodus 22:21). These are not political positions. They are written in the Torah.

3. TZELEM ELOHIM — THE IMAGE OF ELOHIM

Bereishit (Genesis) 1:26–27: every human being — Iranian, Palestinian, Lebanese, Israeli, American — bears the *tzelem Elohim* — the image of **Elohim**. The Yinon Plan explicitly treats Arab populations as ethnographic raw material to be sorted, fragmented, and ruled through proxy militia forces.

Ostrovsky's book documents that Mossad operational doctrine defines agents as "*traitors*" to be "*molded*" and "*used*" — pushed down a hill like a boulder. This is the systematic denial of the tzelem Elohim, applied not only to enemies but to all human instruments of the operation.

4. LO TIRTZACH — DO NOT MURDER

Shemot (Exodus) 20:13: "*Lo Tirtzach.*" The Hebrew root *ratzach* (**H7523**) is distinct from *harag* (general killing). The BDB and HALOT lexical analysis establishes that *ratzach* covers premeditated killing of the innocent, including killing under color of governmental or legal authority. The documented assassination of Khamenei and his family, the civilian deaths at funerals and in refugee camps, and the obliteration of civilian infrastructure across Iran and Lebanon all fall within the *ratzach* standard. As Miqdash Bethel's Lesson 16 "Do Not Murder" establishes: the commandment does not exempt the state.

5. KIDDUSH HASHEM VS. CHILLUL HASHEM

Vayikra (Leviticus) 22:32, the foundation of Lesson 21: "***You shall not profane My holy Name, that I may be sanctified in the midst of the Israelite people — I Yahweh who sanctify you.***"

When those who bear the Name of **Yahweh** — whether Jewish, Christian, or Muslim — act in violation of covenant law, the Name itself is profaned. This is the Chillul Hashem. Invoking "*Baruch hashem*" as Ben Gurion did when the Iraqi nuclear reactor was destroyed, or describing a war of regime change as a "spiritual mission," is precisely the profanation the covenant law prohibits.

VI. THREE-RELIGION COVENANT AUDIT

What we are witnessing is not a prophecy yet to be fulfilled. It is a documented policy being executed.

The Yinon Plan was published in 1982. Every major fragmentation it called for has occurred or is actively underway. Iraq: fragmented. Syria: collapsed and partially occupied. Lebanon: devastated and under ongoing bombardment. Gaza: 86% uninhabitable. West Bank: under accelerating annexation. Iran: under direct military assault with regime change as the stated objective.

Ostrovsky's *By Way of Deception* provides the operational doctrine: an unaccountable intelligence agency with a global volunteer network, operating under the motto "*By way of deception, thou shalt do war,*" manipulating governments, proxy militias, and diaspora networks simultaneously. The Lebanon chapter alone — with Mossad's cultivation of Hobeika, the IDF's illumination of the Shatila massacre, and Israel's observation posts overlooking the killing — is the operational template for what followed in Gaza and is now following in Lebanon and Iran.

The covenant witness of Miqdash Bethel Covenant Assembly to all three Abrahamic faiths is this:

To **Judaism**: The Torah does not authorize what is being done in its name. The profaning of the Name of **Yahweh** through the blood of innocents is the Chillul Hashem — the gravest violation of covenant identity.

To **Christianity**: Dispensationalism is not the Tanakh. The prophets do not describe a God who blesses the obliteration of civilian populations as covenant fulfillment. Yehoshua 21:43–45 stands: the land promises were fulfilled. What continues is imperial expansion in the name of religion.

To **Islam**: The fasad fil-ard — the corruption in the earth — must be named on all sides. Iran's killing of its own people, its support of proxy violence across the region, and its decades of threatening language have fed this fire. Covenant peace requires honest witness to all sin, not selective indictment.

The word of Yahweh through the prophet Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah) 6:14 stands over every party in this conflict: *"They have healed the wound of My people lightly, saying 'Shalom, Shalom,' when there is no shalom."* There is no shalom where dam naki flows and gvulot are moved by military force. The covenant demands more than ceasefire. It demands justice.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Individual: How does the doctrine "By way of deception, thou shalt do war" compare to the covenant standard of **Yahweh's** *emet* — truth — as a foundational attribute of the divine character (Shemot 34:6)?

Community: If a Jewish person would not turn a Mossad katsa in even if they disagreed — out of communal loyalty — how does this challenge or align with the covenant standard of reproof (Vayikra 19:17: *"You shall surely reprove your neighbor and not bear sin because of him"*)?

Nation: The Yinon Plan treats the fragmentation of Arab states as Israel's security strategy. The covenant gives a different security strategy: Devarim 17:16–17, which prohibits the king from multiplying horses (military buildup), wives (political alliances), and gold (economic extraction). How does this standard speak to the current regional war?

World: Every nation that has participated in this conflict — the US, Israel, Iran, the Gulf states, the UK, Pakistan as mediator — has made decisions based on national interest rather than covenant law. What would a genuinely covenant-based international response look like, grounded in the Tanakh's own standards for how nations treat one another (Amos 1–2)?
