## A COVENANT WITNESS RESPONSE

### The Tucker Carlson / Steve Sweeney Interview

## PREAMBLE — WHAT THIS INTERVIEW DOCUMENTS

On April 10, 2026, Tucker Carlson interviewed Steve Sweeney, a British journalist working for RT who lives and works in Beirut, Lebanon. The interview documents the following events, confirmed by Sweeney as a direct eyewitness on the ground:

1. An Israeli F-16, using a U.S.-manufactured GBU-38 munition, fired on Sweeney and his cameraman on a destroyed bridge in southern Lebanon in what Sweeney describes as a deliberate assassination attempt. Both survived only because the missile passed through a hole where the bridge had already been destroyed.
2. The Israeli military has killed more than 50 medical workers in Lebanon, targeted ambulances whose identifying logos now mark them for attack rather than protection, and struck the Jabal Amal hospital.
3. The Israeli military destroyed the shrine of Shemunah Safar — the purported burial site of the Apostle Peter (Saint Peter) — in a deliberate strike. Sweeney visited the site after the ceasefire and described missiles through the domes, bullet marks across all buildings, and the area of the shrine itself destroyed.
4. The Greek Catholic church of Derdegeier was destroyed with eight people sheltering inside killed. The Church of Saint George and the Imam Ali Mosque in Yaroun were both destroyed. A video of an Israeli soldier destroying the statue of Saint George was confirmed by Sweeney.
5. Israeli forces have demolished olive groves — some thousands of years old — and deployed chemical agents to permanently destroy crop-bearing capacity in the soil of southern Lebanon.
6. 1.2 million Lebanese people have been forcibly displaced. Over 370,000 of the displaced are children.
7. Over 15,000 ceasefire violations since November 2024, including drone strikes, targeted assassinations, home demolitions, and the use of white phosphorus.

## **PART ONE — WHAT THIS INTERVIEW GETS RIGHT FROM A COVENANT PERSPECTIVE**

### **Truth One: The Deliberate Targeting of Journalists is Named and Evidenced**

Sweeney does not speculate — he documents. He was in a clearly identified press vehicle wearing press jackets. The Israeli military has the most advanced surveillance technology in the region and knew exactly who was on that bridge. The bridge had already been destroyed; there was no military objective in striking it again. The targeting was deliberate.

The covenant witness standard of **Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:15** demands two or three witnesses to establish any matter. Sweeney provides: (1) the footage itself, (2) his own eyewitness account, (3) the Lebanese Army's confirmation of no pre-warning, (4) weapons experts confirming the munition and platform, and (5) the Russian Foreign Ministry's confirmation that there was no military justification. The evidentiary standard is met.

### **Truth Two: Tucker Correctly Identifies the Pattern of Erasure of Christian Presence**

Tucker asks directly: has Hezbollah blown up Christian holy sites? Has Hezbollah targeted ambulances? Sweeney answers: No — the opposite. Hezbollah was protecting Christian churches and cleaning up after bombings. This assessment is confirmed by Sweeney's two years of ground-level access.

### **Truth Three: Sweeney Correctly Names the Economic and Agrarian Weapon**

The destruction of olive groves combined with chemical agents designed to permanently destroy the soil's crop-bearing capacity is not collateral damage. It is a covenant weapon against a people's connection to their land.

## **PART TWO — COVENANT VIOLATIONS DOCUMENTED IN THIS INTERVIEW**

### **VIOLATION 1: THE SHEDDING OF INNOCENT BLOOD**

*"We were in a clearly identified press vehicle. We had our press jackets on. Israel has the most advanced surveillance technology anywhere in the world. There was no doubt that they knew we were there."*

Steve Sweeney and his cameraman were non-combatants on a bridge with no military value. More than 50 medical workers killed. Ambulances targeted. Hospitals struck. Eight

civilians sheltering in a church killed. 1.2 million displaced, 370,000 of them children. Each of these is a covenant violation of the first order.

***“Do no wrong or violence to the stranger, the fatherless, or the widow, nor shed innocent blood in this place.” — Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah) 22:3***

***“Blood pollutes the land, and no atonement can be made for the land for the blood shed in it, except by the blood of him who shed it.” — Bemidbar (Numbers) 35:33***

***“Woe to him who builds a town with blood and founds a city on iniquity.” — Habakkuk 2:12***

## **VIOLATION 2: THE TARGETING OF HEALERS AND MEDICAL WORKERS**

***“Instead of giving them protection, the logo on the top of the ambulances now places them at risk. So many of them have removed those logos from their emergency vehicles.”***

The covenant law of Yahweh prohibits the shedding of innocent blood categorically. Those who tend the wounded are the furthest possible category from legitimate military targets. The IDF statement that Hezbollah uses medical facilities — issued without evidence — is the use of false witness to justify killing.

***“If a malicious witness arises to accuse a person of wrongdoing, the judges shall inquire diligently... then you shall do to him as he had meant to do to his brother.” — Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:16–19***

***“Do not kill the innocent and righteous, for I will not acquit the wicked.” — Shemot (Exodus) 23:7***

## **VIOLATION 3: THE DELIBERATE DESTRUCTION OF HOLY SITES**

***“This was a deliberately targeted attack on the tomb of Saint Peter. Eight people who had taken shelter inside the Greek Catholic church were killed. Both the Church of Saint George and the Imam Ali Mosque were completely destroyed.”***

Yahweh does not only defend Israelite houses of worship. The deliberate destruction of churches, mosques, and holy shrines is a violation of covenant principle. The attempt to retroactively claim the tomb of Saint Peter as a Jewish holy site to justify its destruction compounds the violation with false witness.

***“You shall not move your neighbor’s landmark, which the men of old have set.” — Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:14***

***“Enough, O princes of Israel! Put away violence and oppression and execute justice and righteousness.” — Yechezkel (Ezekiel) 45:9***

***“Woe to those who devise wickedness... They covet fields and seize them, and houses and take them away.” — Michah (Micah) 2:1–2***

## **VIOLATION 4: THE DESTRUCTION OF THE LAND, CROPS, AND OLIVE GROVES**

***“The use of chemical spray to destroy crops. We witnessed and filmed this. They started bulldozing the olive groves. These are olive groves that are older than the state of Israel. They’ve sprayed chemicals that will make sure these crops will never be able to grow on the land again.”***

The Tanakh's covenant law of warfare contains an explicit prohibition unique in the ancient world: you may not destroy the trees of the land. The deliberate use of chemical agents to permanently destroy crop-bearing capacity goes far beyond what the Torah addresses — it is the weaponization of the land itself against the people who have lived on it for generations.

***“When you besiege a city... you shall not destroy its trees by wielding an axe against them. Are the trees in the field human, that they should be besieged by you?” — Devarim (Deuteronomy) 20:19***

***“The land shall not be sold in perpetuity, for the land is Mine.” — Vayikra (Leviticus) 25:23***

## **VIOLATION 5: THE FORCIBLE DISPLACEMENT OF A PEOPLE FROM THEIR LAND**

***“1.2 million Lebanese people have been forced from their land and homes. 370,000 of those are children. Israel Katz said they want the land.”***

The Tanakh consistently names the forcible displacement of a people from their land — especially when driven by land seizure — as a covenant crime against both the people and Yahweh who holds title to all land. The stated goal is acquisition. The Torah has a word for this: *gezel* — robbery.

***“Woe to those who devise wickedness... They covet fields and seize them, and houses and take them away.” — Michah (Micah) 2:1–2***

***“Thus says Yahweh: Have you murdered and also taken possession?” — Melachim Aleph (1 Kings) 21:19***

***“You shall not oppress a sojourner. You know the heart of a sojourner, for you were sojourners in the land of Egypt.” — Shemot (Exodus) 23:9***

## **VIOLATION 6: THE ASSASSINATION OF WITNESSES AND SUPPRESSION OF TRUTH**

***“This was an assassination attempt by Israel to silence the voices on the ground, to silence the truth... Fatima Fattuni, Ali Schwabe and Mohammed Fattouni were killed in a targeted strike by Israelis just after they'd been reporting.”***

The systematic assassination of journalists is a direct attack on the covenant evidentiary process itself. Yahweh's covenant requires that truth be witnessed, spoken, and heard. Those who silence witnesses attack Yahweh's judicial process.

***“A single witness shall not suffice against a person for any crime... A matter shall be established by the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses.” — Devarim (Deuteronomy) 19:15***

***“You shall not spread a false report. You shall not join hands with a wicked man to be a malicious witness.” — Shemot (Exodus) 23:1***

***“They condemn the innocent to death and do not call the guilty to account.” — Tehillim (Psalms) 94:21***

## **VIOLATION 7: GOVERNMENTS THAT PROVIDE COVER AND WEAPONS FOR THESE VIOLATIONS**

***“Britain is providing the weapons and the ammunition and the political and military support to carry out such strikes... Israel just simply fires the bullets that they’re supplied.”***

The covenant law does not limit accountability to the hand that fires the weapon. It extends to those who provide the weapon, the political cover, and the silence that enables the killing.

***“Cursed be anyone who takes a bribe to shed innocent blood.”*** — *Devarim (Deuteronomy) 27:25*

***“Your princes are rebels and companions of thieves... they do not bring justice to the fatherless.”*** — *Yeshayahu (Isaiah) 1:23*

***“If a ruler listens to falsehood, all his officials will be wicked.”*** — *Mishlei (Proverbs) 29:12*

## **PART THREE — THE MIQDASH BETHEL COVENANT RESPONSE**

### **On the Destruction of Christian Holy Sites**

The covenant response is this: **Yahweh** does not only defend Israelite houses of worship. The covenant principle of protecting places set apart for the worship of **Elohim** is universal. The destruction of a Christian church, a Muslim mosque, or a Jewish synagogue by any military power for territorial purposes is a covenant violation. The identity of the worshippers does not change the nature of the act.

### **On the Question of “Biblical Right” to the Land**

The same Torah that contains the land promise also states: ***“The land shall not be sold in perpetuity, for the land is Mine”*** — **Vayikra (Leviticus) 25:23**. And commands: ***“You shall not oppress a sojourner”*** — **Shemot (Exodus) 23:9**. A religious claim to land used to justify the destruction of that land and the permanent displacement of its people is not a Tanakh-based claim. It is a claim that invokes scripture while violating scripture.

### **On the Role of the Press and the Silencing of Witnesses**

Tucker Carlson’s willingness to platform Sweeney — a journalist who survived an assassination attempt and whose own government has turned against him — is an act of covenant journalism: let the witness speak, let the evidence be examined, let the viewer decide. This is what the two or three witness standard requires.

**YAHWEH’S COVENANT VERDICT:** The same Torah that gives the land promise gives the condition of that promise. The shedding of innocent blood defiles the land (Bemidbar (Numbers) 35:33). No religious claim, no political justification, and no military doctrine alters the standard of **Yahweh**. The word of **Yahweh** through

**Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah)** stands over every government, every military, every press organization, and every religious institution that enables or conceals these things:

***“Stand in the ways and ask for the ancient paths, where the good way is; and walk in it, and find rest for your souls.” — Yirmeyahu (Jeremiah) 6:16***

***“He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does Yahweh require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your Elohim?” — Michah (Micah) 6:8***

## **APPENDIX — IN REMEMBRANCE OF THE FALLEN**

### **Journalists Killed in the Gaza and Lebanon Wars**

**The Voice of the Blood of Every Witness Cries from the Ground. *“The voice of your brother’s blood is crying to Me from the ground.” — Bereishit (Genesis) 4:10 • “Do not kill the innocent and righteous, for I will not acquit the wicked.” — Shemot (Exodus) 23:7***

The following names are recorded in this covenant document as a witness before **Yahweh** and before the nations. These are men and women who bore witness on the ground. They were killed in the exercise of their professional duty as journalists. According to the Committee to Protect Journalists, the International Federation of Journalists, and the United Nations, the Gaza and Lebanon conflicts represent the single deadliest period for journalists in all of recorded history — surpassing the combined total of journalists killed in World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Yugoslav Wars, and the Afghanistan War combined.

UNESCO awarded its 2024 World Press Freedom Prize to the Palestinian journalists of Gaza. This document records their names in covenant respect.
