- Senior home repair pilot program: funding to provide home repair assistance for 5
 homeowners over 60 who own home, have insurance, small target area. Hope that with
 concentrated area visible improvement will impress funders to support more homes.
 After application is complete, it will take a couple months to get started. The program is
 for critical repairs such as roof, leak, electricity, plumbing. Need help spreading the
 word.
- Sidewalk program: if you have a sidewalk that is cracked and terrible, report to 311.
 Beekman Corridor designated for residential sidewalk repairs, usually home owner's responsibility. Prioritizes impairment to mobility. Amnesty to residential properties during program.
