Class Types

At Jindokai Shotokan Karate-Do, we offer structured, purpose-driven classes suitable for all ages and experience levels:

White Belt Classes (Rookie)

A welcoming introduction for beginners, focusing on core movements, confidence, and dojo etiquette.

General Classes

All-ages and all-levels training rooted in traditional Shotokan Karate. These sessions focus on skill progression, kata, and kumite in a structured format.

Competition Development Classes

Designed for students preparing to compete at local, state, or national levels. These classes focus on tournament-style kumite, kata performance, and mental preparation.

Brown & Black Belt Classes

Advanced technical training for senior students. These sessions explore high-level kata, bunkai, and leadership development.

Children at Jindokai

Jindokai Shotokan Karate-Do provides a **structured**, **disciplined learning environment**. Our classes include students of all ages and involve discussions and training around real-life conflict, personal safety, and physical discipline.

This content may be challenging for some young children.

Parents should consider whether their child is ready to participate in a focused, mixed-age setting.

Parental Responsibilities:

- Children under 8 years old must be actively supervised by a parent or guardian at all times.
- Parents must accompany their child to the toilet if needed.
- A If a child is left unattended and requires assistance, they will be asked to sit out until their parent returns.
- If repeated issues occur due to lack of supervision, the child's membership may be suspended or terminated for safety reasons.

Grading Tests (Kyu Levels)

- Kyu Grading Fee \$70 (includes new coloured belt)
 - Grading tests are held regularly throughout the year
 - Students must meet minimum attendance and readiness requirements
 - Instructors will advise when a student is eligible to test
 - Grading is a reflection of both technical development and personal growth

All grading eligibility is based on instructor recommendation, consistent attendance, and demonstration of correct etiquette and effort.
