Campers must agree to the following camping rules:

- Camp fees are as follows: \$20/night with an additional \$25 cash deposit.
  Deposit will be returned once sight has been approved as cleaned prior to leaving.
- Person must be a minimum of 18 years old and show proof of age with valid ID in order to reserve a campsite.
- There is no sewer hookup or dump station, electricity, or water. The only sites available are primitive sites. Clubhouse will be open for restroom use. Personal generators are welcome. Campers may also fill RV reserve tanks from the club's hydrant.
- Campsites will be assigned locations as prescribed by IAC.
- The clubhouse kitchen is off limits to all campers. Only work detail personnel may use the kitchen to prepare meals as needed.
- Iroquois Archery Club are not responsible for any damages to your vehicles, personal belongings or camper.
- No pets allowed.
- No fires will be allowed at individual campsites. Campers must use community fire ring provided by IAC only.

- No drugs or minor consumption allowed. This will be strictly enforced.
  Violaters and included parties will forfeit their right to compete and be asked to leave.
- Quiet hours are 10:00 pm (cst) 6:00 am (cst)
