



Artificial Grass Maintenance Guide

Artificial grass is designed to be low maintenance, which is one of the main reasons homeowners choose it for their residential gardens. While it doesn't require mowing, watering, or fertilising like natural grass, a small amount of simple care will keep your lawn looking fresh and performing well for many years.

Here is a simple artificial grass maintenance guide from 365 Lawns to help you keep your garden looking its best all year round.

1. Remove Leaves and Garden Debris

Over time, leaves, twigs, and other debris may collect on your artificial lawn, especially during autumn. Removing this regularly helps keep the surface clean and prevents organic material from breaking down into the grass fibres.

You can easily clear debris using:

- A leaf blower
- A plastic rake
- A soft garden brush

Regular cleaning will help your artificial lawn maintain its tidy and natural appearance.

2. Brush the Grass Fibres Occasionally

Foot traffic can sometimes cause the fibres of artificial grass to flatten. Brushing the grass helps keep the blades standing upright and restores its natural look.

For best results:

- Use a stiff broom or artificial grass brush



- Brush against the direction of the fibres
- Focus on areas with heavy use such as pathways or play areas

This simple step keeps your lawn looking full and freshly installed.

3. Rinse the Surface When Needed

Artificial grass can occasionally benefit from a quick rinse, especially during dry weather or if the garden is used frequently by pets.

Simply use a garden hose to wash down the surface. This helps remove dust, pollen, and minor spills while keeping the lawn looking clean.

Because artificial grass installed by 365 Lawns includes a proper drainage base, water will easily drain through the lawn.

4. Clean Up After Pets

Artificial grass is very popular with pet owners because it is easy to maintain.

To keep the area fresh:

- Remove solid waste as you would normally
- Rinse the area with water
- For deeper cleaning, use a mild diluted disinfectant or artificial grass cleaner if needed

Proper drainage allows liquids to pass through the lawn, helping prevent odours and keeping the surface hygienic.

5. Prevent Heavy Objects from Damaging the Lawn

Artificial grass is durable, but placing extremely heavy items on the lawn for long periods can flatten the fibres.



To keep your lawn in great condition:

- Move garden furniture occasionally
- Avoid dragging heavy objects across the surface
- Use protective pads under furniture where possible

6. Check Edges and Seams Occasionally

Although professionally installed artificial grass is very secure, it's good practice to occasionally check that edges and joins remain firmly in place.
