COMPETITION PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Any dancer (ages 5 +) interested in becoming part of a competitive dance team environment may audition. Classes are geared towards the serious dancer who shows potential for growth, those who are enthusiastic and passionate about dance and those who are driven to work hard, practice and be part of a team. Dancers must also adhere to our team contract throughout the dance season.

SEASON

Our season runs from September through early May, ending with our year end recital in May. Actual competitions take place February – April while Nationals are held in June. We will be attending <u>four</u> mandatory regional competitions and <u>one OPTIONAL</u> competition this season. These may be held in Green Bay, Stevens Point, Madison, or the Milwaukee area. Our nationals competition is optional and may be held in the Minneapolis, Wisconsin Dells or Chicago area.

CLASSES

Dancers can audition for only the styles of dance they wish to participate in. Participation in at least one group routine is mandatory for all dancers to be eligible for a solo, duo or trio. In addition to the classes a dancer auditions for, ONE ballet and ONE stay strong class is mandatory for all competition dancers (*please see the note below regarding an exception for our youngest team members*). Staff will place dancers in these classes based on age/ability.

Competition classes meet on Sundays. Some solos, duos and trios may have their classes scheduled during the week based on studio and instructor availability. Groups meet for 45 minutes each week, duets and trios meet for 30 minutes each week and solos meet for 30 minutes every other week. Ballet classes are one hour each week and the stay strong class is 45 minutes each week.

<u>NOTE</u>: Our youngest competition team members (generally Pre K - 1st Grade) will have their ballet and stay strong classes combined into a one-hour class to better meet their needs. When audition placements are announced, we will also clarify the dancers who will fall into this category for the combined ballet/stay strong class.

Some dancers, based on skill scores during the audition process, may be required to take a mandatory turns and leaps class during the dance season. This will be determined by creating an average score based on all dancers auditioning. Anyone falling below the average score will be required to take a turns and leaps class to help elevate those skills.

Participation in at least two summer classes is also mandatory for dancers on the competition team. **One of those** classes must be a ballet or PBT class.

ATTENDANCE

Dancers are allowed <u>four</u> absences from each class over the course of the dance season. Practices held the week before a competition are <u>mandatory</u> for all dancers. Any dancer missing a mandatory practice due to illness will be required to turn in a doctor's note. Of the allowable 4 absences, no dancer shall exceed one absence per month from Jan to May. Any dancer with five or more absences from performance-based classes may be removed from the group. Any dancer with five or more absences from a ballet or stay strong class will be required to make those classes up at another time during the week. Dress rehearsal and our annual recitals are also <u>mandatory</u> events for our competition team members. When possible, injured dancers are expected to observe class.

2025-2026 AUDITION DETAILS

There will be short 20 second combos in tap, jazz, lyrical and hip hop that dancers will need to learn and perform at auditions. There will be three different levels of routines to coincide with the audition groups. Dancers only need to learn routines in the styles they plan to audition in.

All audition routines and skill demonstration videos will be posted on our website on Monday, May 12th.

We will also upload a sample of the audition scoresheet so there is complete transparency regarding what skills dancers will need to demonstrate and what dancers are being scored on during the audition process.

OPEN STUDIO

We will be holding two open studio sessions for dancers who would like to work with our staff on audition combos or skills they may need extra work on. This is NOT mandatory for dancers to attend, but this is great for anyone looking for extra practice prior to auditions.

What To Bring For Auditions

- 1. Dancers must dress in plain black clothing. Leggings, tanks, fitted shirts, etc. are all acceptable. Clothing should be fitted so we can see body lines during auditions.
- 2. Hair must be secured back in a bun (low or high is acceptable).
- 3. Proper shoes for the style(s) of dance you are auditioning for.
- 4. Water bottle
- 5. A positive attitude and strong work ethic!

<u>Placement</u>: Placement on our team is determined by our staff based on technique, ability to pick up choreography, age, attitude & performance during previous season (if dancer is a returning member).

RESULTS ARE FINAL

AUDITION RESULTS WILL BE ANNOUNCED ON THURSDAY, MAY 29th (EMAILED TO ALL PARTICIPANTS AND POSTED ON OUR WEBSITE)

CONTRACTS, REGSITRATION FEE (\$50) & DEPOSIT (\$200) ARE DUE ON THURSDAY, JUNE 5TH

Failure to return these items by the deadline will result in your dancer(s) not being placed in our competitive program. This \$200 deposit will go towards dancer's accounts at the end of our dance season unless the team contract has been breached. In that case, the \$200 **DOES NOT** go towards the balance of the account and will be used for the added expenses we incur for having to re-choreograph or re-stage routines and added administrative expenses.
