Please inform Heart of the Valley Dance Academy if your child has problems/conditions that might compromise his/her safe involvement.

You are acknowledging that your child’s participation in any and all events and classes involves known and unknown risks that may result in injuries that may include, but are not limited to, bruises, cuts, dislocation, fractures, sprains, strains, tears. Also, temporary and/or permanent diseases, illnesses, infections and/ or viruses including, but not limited to, Corona, COVID, EBOLA, MERS, And SARS caused by, but limited to, bacteria, virus, fungi, protozoa and/ or helminths.

By registering for one of our programs, you have granted permission to use your child’s photograph for promotional purposes unless otherwise noted. If you wish for your child’s photo not to be used, please return a written letter to the front desk.

Please be prompt for class – Instructors will not back track for students who are tardy.***

The dress code is strictly enforced. The first time a student comes to class in clothing that does not follow the code for their dance medium they will receive a reminder warning letter. Any time after that warning, a child not wearing clothing that follows the dress code for their dance medium will be asked to not participate and only observe class.

Leotards, tights, skirts, t-shirts and other dancewear are for sale at HOTV Dance Academy at various times during the year. Stop at the front desk for help.

Parents are responsible for making payments on time. Each and any payment received after the due date is subject to a \$25.00 late fee. This includes class fees in full, each installment payment and costume fees.

All accounts must be paid in full prior to our annual recital - Students will not be allowed to participate in the recital until all tuition and late fees are paid.

No refunds will be given for missed or cancelled classes, costumes or for withdrawing during the dance season.

HOTVDA reserves the right to move to online classes as needed for safety at any time.

No refunds or deductions will be given for online classes.

Cash, checks and credit cards are accepted.

Fundraising

Fundraising opportunities are available monthly throughout the dance season. Any profits earned may be used towards class fees, costumes, shoes, tights, dance attire, tickets, etc. Fundraising opportunities are:

☑ Kwik Trip Gas Cards (5% profits on cards sold)

Orders must be placed at the front desk by the first Monday of each month. Kwik Trip orders must be paid in full when order is placed. No cash refunds will be given for fundraising credit. No credit card payments are accepted for fundraisers- cash and checks only. Any fundraising payment made by check that is returned by the bank will result in the loss of fundraising opportunities. HOTVDA reserves the right to eliminate fundraising at any time.

Costumes

“Costume Week” will be held the week of October 20th during regular class time. One parent must be present for each dancer. At this class, students will be measured and sized for their costumes; **students will not be dancing**. Parents will have the opportunity to review costume sizes at that time and will sign off on their child’s costume order sheet. We are generous in our measuring to allow for growth between November and April. Any costs to alter a costume will be the parent’s responsibility. Please note that costumes are not sized like street clothes. We always recommend going up a size when in doubt. **Payment for costumes will be due the same evening.**

Late Fees

Each and any payment received after the due date is subject to a \$25.00 late fee. This includes class fees in full, each installment payment and costume fees.

Returned Check Fees

A \$35.00 charge will be applied to any check returned for NSF.

Student and Parent Conduct:

All students and their parents are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly manner and with respect for our instructors, student teachers and all other students, both in person and online. If any student or parent acts in a manner that could jeopardize their safety or the safety of others, that student will be dismissed immediately.

Cancellations

If the Kaukauna Area School District closes early or cancels due to inclement weather, classes at Heart of the Valley Dance Academy will also be cancelled. We will also notify all families through email by 3:00 pm. Please be sure your e-mail is current in our contact information to ensure you receive notice. Cancellations will also be posted on our website and our social media accounts, and TV station WFRV.

Parent Viewing

Parents will be allowed in the dance room to watch the last 10 minutes of class the first full week of the month starting in November. No viewings will be held in January. Staff will allow more viewings if they feel it's necessary to keep parents up to date on the choreography.

Pictures

Pictures are taken the week of March 3rd-7th by professional photographers of Debbie Daanen Photography. The purchase of pictures is optional, and no money is due upfront. Orders are placed after viewing the photos online. We do ask all students to participate in the class photos which will be posted at the revue.

Food and Drinks

We ask that all food and drink, except water, be kept in the waiting room area. Only water will be allowed in the dance rooms. Children will not be allowed to chew gum in class.

Practice Time

Our staff works hard during class time to teach choreography and review dances, but practice outside of class is important. We encourage ten minutes of practice three times a week.

Newsletters

Heart of the Valley Dance Academy will publish a monthly newsletter with information on upcoming events, reminders and other information. Families that have included an e-mail address will receive a newsletter via email. Copies of the newsletter will also be available at the front desk. Information will also be posted on our website and social media.

Recital Info

HOTV Dance Academy holds an annual recital. The recital dates for the 2024-2025 dance recitals are Friday, May 9 and Saturday, May 10, 2025. The recital will be held at Kaukauna High School's Auditorium. Start time on Friday is 6:30 pm. Our Saturday afternoon show will begin at 1:00 pm and our Saturday evening shows is at 6:00 pm. *Each class performs in two of the three recitals. Please see the class schedule for which recitals your class performs in.*

Students will be required to be at the auditorium 20 minutes prior to show time. Anyone wishing to go backstage will be required to show a backstage pass that only parents/guardians of dance students will receive. There will be no video taping or flash photography during the show. Students will not be allowed in the auditorium to watch the show. Parents are asked to remain seated and only leave the auditorium in between numbers. We have a fast paced, professionally run recital. These rules will be enforced to maintain that level of performance.

Dress rehearsals will be held on Monday, May 5. Each recital number will perform at this rehearsal. A rehearsal schedule will be available for parents in early April. Rehearsals will start no earlier than 4:30 pm and end no later than 8:45 pm. Both rehearsals will also be open to parent to watch and take photos or video. More complete information on dress rehearsals and the recital will be available in early April.

Tickets for the Review

Tickets for the recital will be sold online through dancerecitaltickets.com. Each family will receive an ordering code to purchase tickets for each show. Tickets will be limited based on the total number of families enrolled at the studio (approximately 6-8 tickets per show). After a limited number of days, tickets sales will open, and no codes will be needed. All tickets are reserved seating.

Heart of the Valley Dance Academy Competition Team

Heart of the Valley Dance Academy's competition team is for dance students interested in dancing at a competitive level. It is open to students of all ages. Students in all forms of dance are invited to join. Dancers should be prepared for lots of hard work and practice and be committed to dancing at a competitive level.

Dancers must try- out to be placed on the competition team. There are additional fees involved and weekly 30 - 60-minute classes beginning September and running through April. Competition classes will usually be held on Sunday afternoons or evenings. Competition enrollment is due in May of each year. Try- outs are held in May as well. Competitive dance students are required to take summer classes as well as take part in additional yearlong ballet and strength and conditioning classes.
