


In honor of Pi Day, we will have a scavenger hunt at the Woodlands. Also, for those of you who will be dining with us for lunch, we will have pie for dessert!

WOODLAND TRIPS 2025

April 7, 2025: *DeBrand Chocolate Factory (Ft. Wayne)*. We will have a great tour of the DeBrand Chocolate Factory and eat lunch at the Lucky Turtle Grille/Lucky Moose Lounge; but first, we'll stop at Rise 'N Roll for breakfast! Weather permitting, we will also explore Salomon Farm and see the animals in the afternoon. The cost is \$60, which includes transportation on a Transit bus, the DeBrand Chocolate Factory tour, entrance to Salomon Farm, plus snacks with water and juice. The cost of breakfast and lunch <u>are not</u> included. Full payment is due by March 17.

April 10, 2025: *Four Winds Casino (South Bend).* Try your luck at Four Winds! The cost is \$35, which includes transportation on a Transit bus, snacks, water and juice. **Full payment is due by March 28.**

May 8, 2025: "Nunsense" at Cornwell's Turkeyville (Marshall, MI). "Nunsense is habit-forming! The nuns pull out all the stops in a fundraising variety show featuring tap dancing, habit humor, an audience quiz and a special appearance by convent cook, Sister Julia, Child of God. The clever story has an unabashed desire to make you laugh. With songs and comic interludes paced at break-neck speed, it's a must-see musical adventure!" The cost is \$145, which includes transportation on a Royal Excursion bus, turkey buffet and show, plus snacks with water and juice. First payment of \$45 is due by March 7 to reserve your spot. Balance of \$100 is due by April 11.

June 5, 2025: Dairy Learning Center and Wassenberg Art Center (Celina & Van Wert, OH). We start our trip with lunch at Pullman Bay Park overlooking Grand Lake. Afterwards, we'll visit the MVP Dairy Learning Center that offers two floors of learning the "ins and outs" of a dairy farm. Then comes the Wassenberg Art Center where there will be an opening celebration of their new exhibition, complete with snacks! We will conclude our trip at The Brumback Library for a "photo op" in appreciation of its beautiful architecture. This library is known for being the first County Library formed in the United States. Time permitting, we can enter the library to view its classic interior. The cost is \$135, which includes transportation on a Royal Excursion bus, lunch, entry fees, snacks, juice and water. First payment of \$50 is due by April 11 to reserve your spot. Balance of \$85 is due by April 28.

June 12, 2025: Four Winds Casino (South Bend). Try your luck at Four Winds! The cost is \$35, which includes transportation on a Transit bus, snacks, water and juice. Full payment is due by May 30.

WOODLAND TRIPS 2025

June 17, 2025: *Ride the Dixie!* (*North Webster*). We will have a 1 ¼ hour ride on the Dixie followed by lunch at the Boathouse Restaurant then dessert at the ice cream parlor. You'll have time to wander around Winona Village or work on a ceramic/glass piece of art (please let Nancy Lou know if you wish to do an art piece so that she can reserve a spot for you). The cost is \$77, which includes transportation on a Transit bus, the Dixie ride, snacks, water and juice. The cost of lunch <u>is not</u> included. Full payment is due by May 30.

June 25, 2025: Stones Trace & Annie Oakley Perfumery (Ligonier). Our first stop will be the historic site of Stones Trace where we'll have a tour of the grounds, then we'll head to Fashion Farm for lunch and explore their flower shop. 
