ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

WOODLAND TRIPS 2025

April 7, 2025: DeBrand Chocolate Factory (Ft. Wayne). We will have a great tour of the DeBrand Chocolate Factory and eat lunch at the Lucky Turtle Grille/Lucky Moose Lounge; but first, we'll stop at Rise 'N Roll for breakfast! Weather permitting, we will also explore Salomon Farm and see the animals in the afternoon. 
