WOODLAND TRIPS 2025

April 7, 2025: DeBrand Chocolate Factory (Ft. Wayne). We will have a great tour of the DeBrand Chocolate Factory and eat lunch at the Lucky Turtle Grille/Lucky Moose Lounge; but first, we'll stop at Rise 'N Roll for breakfast! The senior food pantry is available to seniors **50+** who find themselves short on non-perishable grocery items. It can be used as a supplemental food source <u>one time per month</u>. Pantry hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 9 am - 10:30 am & 1 pm - 2 pm.

WOODLANDS FOOD SHARE PROGRAM


