EQUIPMENT LOAN PROGRAM

SHORT-TERM LOANER EQUIPMENT

Walkers, canes, crutches, and shower chairs require a \$10 deposit. Wheelchairs and knee scooters require a \$25 deposit.

Incontinence items are also available. Each recipient is allowed one package per month.

FOOD PROGRAMS

WEEKEND MEALS

Order as many weekend meals as you like by Wednesday at noon, then pick them up on Friday or have them delivered. Call the Woodlands for more details.

NON-PERISHABLE FOOD PANTRY

The senior food pantry is available to seniors **50+** who find themselves short on non-perishable grocery items. It can be used as a supplemental food source **one time per month**. Pantry hours are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 9 am - 10:30 am & 1 pm - 2 pm.

**Bread is available dependent on supply.

WOODLANDS FOOD SHARE PROGRAM

Seniors living on a limited income and in need of additional food items on an ongoing basis can apply for a supplemental food program. The program provides a 10 to 15 lb bag of shelf stable food items **one time per month**. Call the Woodlands for more details.


