Dear Mr. Devney:

Your July 24, 2026 public records request email to the Albany County District Court Clerk was forwarded to me for review and response. After reviewing your email, the information provided to you by the Wyoming Judicial Branch's Administrative Office of the Courts, and speaking with our District Court Clerk, my understanding of your remaining records request to the Albany County District Court Clerk is that you are asking for bulk document production of "summary judgment, Rule 68 judgments, and the underlying case data" from all relevant cases listed on the Judge Westby Case Dispositions reports provided to you by the AOC.

While the Albany County District Court Clerk's Office is the custodian of the specific case records of the cases identified in the AOC reports, and as noted by Ms. Butler in the AOC's July 13, 2026 response to your above request, "[t]he request for documents from the District Court Clerk's Office must be specific. Bulk requests for documents are considered unreasonable due to resource limitations." Your remaining request is a bulk request, and the Albany County District Court Clerk's Office is unable to produce records pursuant to that request.

If and when you identify and provide a listing of 1) specific cases from the Judge Westby Case Dispositions reports provided to you by the Wyoming Judicial Branch, and 2) the specific documents you are requesting from each of those identified and specific cases, your records request will be reviewed and processed. Without that information, the Albany County District Court Clerk cannot and does not compile or extract data in the bulk format you have requested.

Please note that in person inspection of public records is available at no charge, but there are charges for the reasonable costs of producing and constructing a copy of an electronic public record for inspection and copying. This cost may include, but is not limited to, the time spent retrieving, compiling, sorting, reviewing, redacting, formatting, converting, or copying the electronic public record.

If no further information is provided, we will consider this request closed in 30 days from the date of this letter.
