

2025 WCYF Offshore Division Rules

- * WCYF tournament committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any individual for any reason!
- * Any individual who has been arrested for fishing tournament cheating/fraud will be refused entry into this tournament.
- ALL ENTRANTS MUST HAVE REGISTRATION/WEIGHT CARD ON FILE AT PAVILION BEFORE 10:00 P.M. FRIDAY, May 23, 2025 TO WEIGH IN FISH!
- * Entrants must have a valid 2025 Texas Fishing License and Saltwater Stamp. (NO WCYF MEMBER IS ALLOWED TO ENTER!)
- * No fish will be accepted for judging from a non-registered contestant. Anglers will be issued a wristband at registration. **Anglers must show their ticket, photo ID, and fishing license at weigh-in.** Entry fee: \$150 per boat (up to 3 anglers). Species are: Red Snapper, King Mackerel, Cobia (Ling), Bonito, & Shark. Cash prizes are: 1st-\$250 and trophy, 2nd-\$150 for each species.
- * Fishing hours are from 6:00 am to 4:00 pm Saturday, May 24, 2025. (NO NIGHT FISHING)
- * Weigh-in will be at the Community Pavilion at the Port Mansfield Harbor May 24, 2025 from 12:00 pm (noon) 4:00 pm. NO EXCEPTIONS. Tournament Chairman and Weigh Master will have the official time.
- * Winning fish will be determined by weight. Ties will be broken by length. If needed, the final tiebreaker will be determined by who weighed in first. (Lengths will be measured according to the current Texas Parks and Wildlife Department regulations and procedures.)
- * The right to forensically examine any fish will be reserved by the Weigh Master.
- * Fish must be fresh and in edible condition. No mutilated or altered fish will be accepted.

 1 verb If a person or animal is mutilated, their body is severely damaged, usually by someone who physically attacks them.

- * All weighed fish will be marked by removing a pectoral fin.
- * An angler cannot win more than one prize in any species. (Each angler must weigh in their own fish!)
- * Any fish that does not meet the State Limits at the weigh station will be disqualified.
- * FISH WILL BE WEIGHED ONLY ONE TIME! OUR SCALES AND RULER ARE THE ONLY OFFICIAL MEASURING INSTRUMENTS.
- * TOURNAMENT CHAIRMAN'S TIMEPIECE WILL BE USED FOR OFFICIAL TIME.
- * DECISIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT CHAIRMAN and WEIGH MASTER ARE FINAL!
- * Entrants and winners may be photographed or included in TV news coverage during or after the tournament.
- * Entrants may be required to submit statements or pass a polygraph test if deemed necessary by the tournament committee; failure to do so may result in disqualification and loss of any awards, prizes, or titles.
