LOTTERY ONLINE APPLICATIONS ONLY will be accepted on: Wednesday, July 5, 2017 (beginning at 12:01 a.m.) through Thursday, July 6, 2017 (ending at 11:59p.m.) – Mountain Daylight Time. **During this time, interested individuals may submit an application via the Internet at Colorado Springs Housing Authority (CSHA) Website: www.csha.us Applications will not be accepted in the office.**

All applications accepted during the open time frame will be randomly assigned a lottery number for selection when there are available vouchers. **At the end of each lottery year, any remaining applications will be removed and families must reapply when the waiting list reopens.**

If you are person with a disability and need a reasonable accommodation to participate in the application process, please inform our office.

Selected and approved families will need to meet the following basic program requirements to include but is not limited to:

Meet HUD basic eligibility requirements:

- Any household member is not subject to a lifetime registration requirement under a state sex offender registration program
- Any household member has not ever been convicted of drug-related criminal activity for the production or manufacture of methamphetamine on the premises of federally assisted housing
- Any member of the household has not been evicted from federally-assisted housing in the last 3 years for drug-related criminal activity.
- Any family member has not been evicted from federally-assisted housing in the last five years.
- Any family member does not owe monies to any subsidized housing programs, unless the family repays the full amount of the debt 30 days from being notified of the debt.
- Any family does not exceed income guidelines
