COVID-19 Vaccine Update

El Paso County is currently vaccinating priority populations in Phases 1A and 1B of Colorado's phased vaccine distribution plan. This includes high-risk health care workers and everyone age 70 and over. Currently, there is a limited supply of vaccines, and it will take some time for the supply to catch up to the demand.

As of Monday, January 25, a total of 39,479 doses have been administered in El Paso County, which includes 12,993 for seniors 70+. Over the last week, we have averaged 1,364 doses per day, and now 8,479 people have received the two doses needed to complete their vaccination. Approximately 20% (12,993) of seniors 70 years and older have received at least the first dose, but based on the need to provide two doses to approximately 65,000 people, it will take at least through the end of February to vaccinate everyone in this group. If you have registered for a vaccine with one of our many providers please know they will contact you as soon as your vaccine is available, but it may take a few weeks to receive the vaccine.

Until the vaccine is widely available, it is important that everyone, including those who have received the vaccine, continue to follow prevention measures to slow the spread of the virus—wear a mask, practice social distancing, wash hands frequently, and stay home when you are sick.
