To oversee and participate in the activities and services of the Project Based Vouchers, Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA/HOME), Mod Rehab, Mod Rehab SRO, VA Shelter Plus Care and other Public Housing and rental assistance programs; S8 Voucher program assistance as assigned.

Verify applicant data; determine program eligibility; provide highly responsible and complex support to higher level management staff. Tenant, landlord and community relations coordinator; manage concerns, issues and complaints; serve as liaison for referrals between tenants, landlords and outside agencies.

Quality Control of tenant files to ensure compliance with various programs according to pertinent Federal, State and local laws, codes, regulations and Housing Authority policies and procedures.

Serve as liaison for HUD as needed.
