

DANSETTE RECORD PLAYER SOUND QUALITY GUIDE

A quick overview by Tutti Audio's Bob Amos

We often get asked does the sound quality vary between Dansette models. Well, the answer is yes. There are a number of factors at play here with the topology of the amplifier, loudspeaker arrangement, turntable, cabinet size and cartridge/stylus being the prime drivers. To help simplify things we have prepared a basic table of the most popular models in descending order of sound quality. In some cases the difference is marginal. The first being best in terms of sound quality and in general, volume level too. Remember though, out and out sound quality and volume levels are not always top of peoples' list. Indeed, it can be somewhat subjective from person to person. Clearly with Dansettes, aesthetics is often a key overriding consideration. Whatever model you choose though, you'll love its warm, engaging valve sound. They are all fabulous in their own special way!

Dansette HiFi (MKI & MKII) & Imperial HiFi

Dansette Monarch

Dansette Stereophonic & Conquest Auto

Dansette RG65 & RG31 (Radiograms)

Dansette Major Deluxe, Bermuda, Major, Tempo, Challenge & Senator
