Each application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation. These recommendations may come from a teacher, counselor, employer, or coach and should be in a sealed envelope.

<u>Eligibility:</u> A senior from a Douglas County or South Fulton high school graduating in the 2018-2019 academic year. There is no GPA or financial need requirement for this scholarship.

Amount: A one-time Award will be presented on Senior Awards Night at each winner's respective high school.

Award Date: All Award recipients will be notified no later than April 30, 2019.
