Proposal Requisites

BFAM, Inc. incorporates The Bobby Tillman Pact© in all its activities. Make sure the proposal embodies a minimum of four (4) principles of the Pact. Also include how you will use your education/training to better our community and improve social conditions amongst the lives of young people. You will be judged on both the substance of your proposal and your creativity. Minimum of 1,000 words (attach proposal to application).

The Bobby Tillman Scholarship will be presented to high school seniors desiring to further his/her education at a four-year College/University or Technical/Trade school. The funds awarded may be applied towards necessary expenses related to the education process. Applications will be available at the career centers of all Douglas County and South Fulton County High Schools and by request through email at bfaminc1107@gmail.com. Each application must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation. These recommendations may come from a teacher, counselor, employer, mentor, or coach and should be in a sealed envelope.

Application Deadline: All applications with sealed recommendation letters must be post marked no later than: Friday, April 17, 2020.

<u>Eligibility:</u> Seniors from a Douglas County or South Fulton County high school graduating in the 2019-2020 academic year with post high school education plans. There is no GPA or financial need requirement for this scholarship.

<u>Amount:</u> A one-time Award will be presented on Senior Awards Night/Breakfast at each winner's respective high school.
