As appropriate, this could serve as a "Service Learning Project" or Physical Education.

The physical 2020 Greater Dallas Veterans Day Parade is being reimagined to a Virtual Veterans Day Celebration and Experience, but there IS a way for our Cadets to honor veterans during this pandemic!

**Purpose:** Engage Cadets and community; focusing on Veterans Day and in particular the Greater Dallas Veterans Foundation 2020 theme of "Commemorating the 75th Anniversary of the End of WW II."

**Event Theme:** Moving for Vets With 75 in Mind

Possible options for cadets that the JROTC programs can use should include the production of Vignettes to be used in some way during the project. Review JROTC "Medal of Honor Lessons" with WWII in mind or research on their own. Focusing the time 1 – 11 November 2020 but you could start the reach early. The deadline to turn in results will be 16 November 2020.

1. Walk/ Run /Ruck 7 days: 1 mile each day for 6 days and on the 7th day 1.5 miles with the Vignette pinned on them and discussed at some point.
2. Walk/ Run /Ruck one time 7.5 miles with the Vignette pinned on them and discussed at some point.
3. Walk/ Run /Ruck for 7 and ½ hours with the Vignette pinned on them and discussed at some point.
4. Walk/ Run /Ruck for 7 days: 1 hour each day for 6 days and on the 7th day 1.5 hours with the Vignette pinned on them and discussed at some point.
5. Make up a virtual team (Zoom Contact Only) of 7 members covering 75 miles.
6. Make up a virtual team (Zoom Contact Only) of 7 members covering 75 hours for as far as they can.

Total hours, miles and participates for each school/unit will be reported to the Dallas ISD JROTC Headquarters for calculating volunteer hours, NLT 16 November 2020: CSM Lonnie Clark, LClark@dallasisd.org

Certificates will be awarded for participation to each of the programs and cadets. A blank, signed certificate will be used and the programs can type in the names and gather the volunteer hours, miles and participants.
