

Contact the Warwick School Board now!

We need your help to stand up to censorship and pressure groups in Warwick schools!

Please join us in speaking up during the Warwick school board meeting at 7:00 p.m. on May 21 (auditorium of Warwick Middle School, 401 Maple St, Lititz), The school board is considering policy changes that could lead to censorship and potentially violate the rights of students and parents, and on May 21, the Warwick School Board will vote on whether to sign a contract to consult with the Independence Law Center, an activist law firm that promotes anti-LGBTQ+ views and policies. The group has been responsible for dividing multiple communities in Pennsylvania, and we do not want them interfering in our schools!

We need as many community residents and parents as possible to attend and sign up to speak. If you aren't comfortable speaking, please show up to support those who do. We Are Lititz is hoping to fill the seats inside, the foyer, and outside areas with community members who oppose censorship and hiring a divisive outside organization to make decisions for our schools. The numbers matter!

We also encourage community residents and parents to email school board members and tell them to not to dissolve the Library Review Committee and to not to sign a contract with Independence Law Center.

Individuals interested in providing public comments must provide their name, their address, and their topic of comment to the board secretary at boardsecretary@warwicksd.org before 4:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting. When making a comment, individuals must state their name, the topic they will be speaking on, and which agenda item is related to their comment. The related agenda item is "Approval of Additional Legal Counsel." Here is the meeting agenda with instructions for speaking.

Warwick SD already has two board-approved solicitors and a highly effective Library Review Committee made up of students, teachers, librarians, and community members —there is no reason to fast-track the hiring of an outside firm to disrupt our successful policies and procedures.
