

TICK LIST

The Green Homes Grant Scheme

Some clients have expressed uncertainty in relation to the process and structure for claiming for the grant.

We hope that this tick list will assist you in navigating the availability of this grant. To be eligible for any of the secondary measures, you must first install one of the primary energy efficiency measures from the list below:

Primary measures

- Insulation: Solid wall insulation, cavity wall insulation, under-floor insulation, loft insulation, flat roof insulation, room in roof insulation, park home insulation, this can also include top up insulation (we install this)*
- Air source heat pump (we do not install these)*
- Ground source heat pump (we do not install these)*
- Solar Thermal (we do not install these)*

You must be able to tick one of these boxes before you consider any secondary measures.

Secondary measures

- Double glazing, triple glazing or secondary glazing (only when it is replacing single glazing - you cannot move from double to triple glazing) (we source and install these)*
- Energy efficient doors (only if replacing doors installed before 2002) (we source and install these)*
- Hot water tank thermostat or appliance thermostat Hot water tank insulation Smart heating controls, zone controls, thermostatic radiator valves (TRVs) (we do not install these)*
- Draught proofing (we source and install this)*

How does it work out (in number terms)?

If you apply for a £1,500 voucher for insulation (a primary measure), you can receive up to £1,500 for a secondary measure (windows). You would not be able to access funding for windows if you have not accessed a primary measure.

Please remember that the Government is only covering two thirds of the cost so if you received a voucher for £1,500, this would be two thirds of the cost and you would be required to fund the remaining one third.
