#### **ZOOM EXPECTATIONS**

We had a wonderful first week of school with the transition to a fully-virtual education experience. As we proceed through the semester, please note that there are basic expectations in regards to participation with the zoom classes:

## <u>HYDRATION</u>

San Antonio summers are HOT. It is vital to each students' health that members are drinking water in large quantities beginning NOW. Waiting until the first day of band camp to begin drinking water will result in a high risk for dehydration. We give the students frequent breaks in order to keep them healthy during rehearsals, but we are ultimately not responsible for the decisions made outside of rehearsal time. We will review this information with students at length during our initial days of camp. Students should never be afraid to run out of water, as we have a replacement cooler full of cold water at every rehearsal. This should never be used at the primary source of water, only to re-fill jugs after they are empty. All jugs (minimum of ½ gallon) are to be filled before every rehearsal.

## NO CASH IN THE BLUE BOX!!

We (I) have not done a good job of enforcing our "no cash" policy for any payments going to the blue box, but it is extremely important based on our recent events that all payments be check or money order. Although more inconvenient, we have to ensure that your payments are safe, and the people handling money are safe as well. Again, please make sure all payments are made by check or money order.
