





Marching Season Overview

- Mini Band Camp and Round Up in May
- Mandatory Summer Band Training in July
- Round-Up (make up day) in August
- Football game performances 5A district - September through November, weekly
- Marching band competitions –
 Saturdays in late September, most of October
- Pep rallies weekly, immediately before/after school hours
- Parades Day Parade, Battle of the Bands (spring semester)


Summer Band Training Dates

What is it?

- Physical movement, indoor and outdoor.
- Music blocks: sectional, instrument family, full band.
- Team building, relationship building.

Is it mandatory?

- Yes it is mandatory. Summer band attendance will dictate which students have "spots" in the marching show.



Spring Overview

- January Winter Guard and Indoor Percussion contests, school musical
- February Jazz Contests, Winter Guard and Indoor Percussion cont'd
- March Spring trip (every other year), Winter Guard and Indoor Percussion cont'd
- April Fiesta parades (every other year), Jazz Band contests, UIL Concert
 & Sight-Reading Contest
- May Solo and ensemble, concert band festivals, spring concert, graduation band, band banquet, mini band camp

Concert Band Weekly Rehearsals

- · Symphonic Band and Concert Band
 - 2 rehearsals after school (typically 2 hours long)
- · Wind Ensemble
 - 1 sectional rehearsal before OR after school (typically 1 hour long)
 - 2 full band rehearsals after school (typically 2 hours long)
- · Additional Ensemble Rehearsals (Symphony Orchestra, Jazz Band, Musical, etc.)
 - · 1 full ensemble rehearsal before OR after school (typically 1.5 hrs long)

Winter Guard

- Weekly rehearsals 3 to 4 per week, typically 3-4 hour blocks after school day ends, occasional Saturdays
- Competitive season is end of January First week in April. Rehearsals begin after marching season is done
- Most contests in San Antonio & Austin area TECA, WGI

Jazz Band

- Audition based
 - Morning Rehearsals Fall Season (not to conflict with marching)
 - Afternoon/Morning Rehearsals in Spring
- February April competition season
- Curricular jazz class period not required, but highly encouraged (instrumental ensemble)

BAND FEES

• Band Fees are determined in May after looking at enrollment. We divide the cost of the entire program evenly between the number of students enrolled. This year's fees were \$700

MacArthur BPA

- Band Parent Association helps the band organize events, volunteers, meal options for students, arrange for transportation, purchase equipment, help organize banquet, help build props, pay for some marching band expenses, AND MUCH MORE
- They help give each student the best experience possible by lowering the cost of participation.
