These guidelines serve to maximize the productivity and potential of the CAMCA Regional Forum and its mission.

General Attendance Policies

- The Forum dress code is business professional.
- Participants should arrive on time to avoid disruption of Forum programming.
- Please silence electronic devices during Forum sessions.
- Although you are welcome to take photographs or videos during the Forum, please avoid distracting participants or disrupting sessions.
- Adhere to the policies and regulations of the Forum venue and respect the directives of venue and Forum staff.
- For audience members asking a question during any Q&A, introduce yourself and your affiliation before asking a precise and succinct question.
- The CAMCA Regional Forum is a non-political and non-partisan Forum designed to foster greater regional dialogue and cooperation. Acknowledging the diversity of perspectives among participants and the necessity of open discourse, the Forum organizers encourage participants to be courteous and considerate, acting in good faith and using appropriate language and behavior. Understanding that participants may express policy disagreements, the CAMCA Forum is a platform for constructive and respectful discussion, working towards the betterment of the entire region and all participating countries.
- The CAMCA Regional Forum promotes intraregional cooperation through transparent and open dialogue. In keeping with this spirit, unless stated otherwise, Forum organizers will record and circulate sessions with the press and public. Participants are also free, unless stated otherwise, to use information received during the Forum and are not prevented from publicly disclosing the identities and affiliations of speakers.
- The CAMCA Regional Forum is committed to providing a safe and respectful environment for all Forum attendees and staff. The Forum will not tolerate harassment of any kind. Penalties for violations include, but are not limited to, expulsion and/or banning from future Forums.
