Over the past few days, I have been asked a number of times, "How was your Christmas?" "Different!," usually has been my first response. Of course, Christmas 2020, could not have been anything but "different," but that wasn't all.

As I have reflected further, I am aware that my experience of this Christmas, even in this year of pandemic, was, for the most part, the same heartwarming, substantive and holy experience it has always been for me. I am blessed that I was brought to church as a child, so that the carols, the decorations, the Nativity story, and the prayers and pageantry were woven into my inner sense of the Mystery of Christmas. It had comforting power then, and it still does.

In fact, as we shared the Body and Blood of Christ, even from tiny chalices, I sensed we were truly One in Christ. As the Dismissal was pronounced, I left our blessed time together feeling that I had truly been to Christ-Mass. I hope you felt that way too!
