Endings and Beginnings

On May 18th, we who gathered in the Cathedral Church of St. Paul experienced the power of the Holy Spirit moving in our midst! Did we hear powerful rushing wind, and did we see flames as of fire descending as at the first Pentecost? Perhaps close!

In the late morning, in a dramatic moment, as presider of the Election Convention, Bishop Ely declared, õThe first ballot is open.ö A solemn silence descended upon the gathered clergy and lay delegates as each processed forward and deposited his or her individual ballot in the boxes provided. The bishop then declared, õThe first ballot is now closedö. The lay and clergy ballot boxes were then passed securely into the custody of the official tellers who adjourned into two subcommittees to count the ballots. Clergy and Delegates talked quietly with one another. A time of excited but subdued expectation took place as we waited for the tellers to do their counting.

The Holy Spirit did indeed make its presence known as the tabulation of votes was presented and Bishop Ely announced, õWe have an election!ö Perhaps not exactly the wind from heaven but a powerful eruption of resounding applause reverberated and pulsed off the inner walls of the nave of the Cathedral in wave after wave of jubilation, exultation and joy...and reverberated and reverberated! An election on the first ballot! What an affirmation! The Holy Spirit indeed, doing its will and work!

And so it was that on Saturday, May 18th, the Diocese of Vermont chose the Rev. Shannon MacVean-Brown as its 11th Bishop! Bishop-Elect Shannon immediately was contacted by Bishop Ely and members of the Standing Committee and she said she was õbeyond wordsö with joy and would come to be with us in Vermont as soon as possible.

True to her word, Bishop-Elect Shannon will indeed visit Vermont by the end of May, be present at the June 1st meeting of the Commission on Ministry-Committee on Discernment, and has called for a Clergy Day to meet diocesan clergy on June 4th. Other details of her arrival dates are yet to be announced, but likely in early July.

Leave-takings and beginnings are the substance of our Scriptures during this time of the Church Year as we have been reading JesusøõFarewell Discoursesö in the Gospel according to John. Jesus was preparing his disciples for what was to come, including what would sustain them as they dealt with the aftermath of his arrest, crucifixion, and resurrection. Jesus promised that they would experience the Comforter, the Presence and Power of the Holy Spirit.

As the people of the Episcopal Church in Vermont, we are experiencing an ending as Bishop Tom Ely retires and, as he puts it, passes on the Crosier (Bishop& staff) to the new Bishop at her consecration. By the Grace of God and the Sustaining of the Holy Spirit, we have already entered the preface to this new chapter in the life of our diocese with Bishop Shannon. She will be officially consecrated on September 28th at Ira Allen Chapel.

May the Grace of God bless and sustain them and us in this Pentecost time,

Safer Church Basic Training

The Episcopal Church in Vermont will offer a Safer Church Basic Training at All Saints on **Saturday, June 22, 2019,** from **8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.** Topics include power, authority, and boundaries in ministerial relationships, and prevention, identification, and response to elder, child, and youth abuse among other topics.

Persons who are paid or volunteer with children or youth or any vulnerable population, Eucharistic Visitors, and employees of a congregation are required to take this training. All other leaders and members of our congregation are encouraged to attend.
