Jesus asked Peter again, 'Do you love Me?' And he said to Him, 'Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You.' Jesus said to him, 'Feed My sheep.'

This past Sunday at All Saints, we had the privilege of hearing from Patrick Leduc, representing the group of South Burlington citizens working to establish a South Burlington Food Shelf. This effort is to address a significant problem that has been largely unrecognized in our local community; namely, food insecurity. Following are some of the surprising facts about food insecurity in this, often viewed as affluent, South Burlington community:

In Vermont, Food insecurity is a real problem. There are over 64,000 Vermonters living in food insecure households, and South Burlington is not immune. To bring it close to home, the Vermont Agency of Education reported that in the 2018-2019 school year there are 572 students eligible for Free and Reduced Lunches (FRL) in our South Burlington Schools – that is 23% of our students and close to that many households with young children in need. We estimate there are another 350 households, with citizens over 65, that struggle to put food on the table.

We heard from Patrick that considerable progress has been made toward establishing the South Burlington Food Shelf. A location at 356 Dorset Street has been secured. Repairs and alterations to the property are being scheduled. A great deal of organizational work has been done to invite the involvement of many diverse individuals and organizations.

Our All Saints representative to this effort has been Josh Cheney, who has also been appointed a member of the Advisory Board of the Food Shelf.

Clearly there are many things which will need to come together to meet the tentative goal of opening the Food Shelf by the end of summer. Once opened, it is envisioned that the Food Shelf will be open one weekday during the day, another weekday evening and a weekend day. As the actual operation of the Food Shelf begins to get underway, volunteers will be needed to fill these shifts. What a fun opportunity it would be for some of us at All Saints to fill one of these shifts! Donations of time and energy will be important for the Food Shelf to fulfill its mission.

Of course, financial donations will be important for sustaining the Food Shelf. In response, All Saints Outreach Committee will make an initial donation of three hundred dollars.

This food shelf effort has been spearheaded by South Burlington community members who are doing so out of a commitment to bring their faith to bear on meeting societal needs. Let us join them in supporting this tangible expression of faith.
