We strongly encourage you to participate and to invite your children to grow in faith, friendship, and knowledge of God.

PROPER POSTURE FOR PRAYER DURING THE EASTER SEASON – From the celebration of Pascha (Resurrection Matins) until the Kneeling Prayers at Pentecost, the traditional posture for prayer in the Byzantine tradition is to stand rather than to kneel. Standing is a sign of the Resurrection and expresses our joy in the Risen Christ. During this festal period, the Church invites us to pray as a people redeemed and raised up with Christ, reflecting the ancient practice of the Christian East. For this reason, kneeling is set aside until Pentecost, when the Church again introduces kneeling prayers. This practice has been encouraged in the parishes of the Byzantine Catholic Church, particularly within the Metropolitan Church of Pittsburgh, in accordance with directives of the bishops issued in 2006, as part of a broader effort to recover authentic liturgical tradition.

Those who are not physically able to stand are, of course, free to sit or kneel as needed. If you have any questions, please feel free to speak with Fr. Yuriy.
