Church and Parish Hall projects

For several years, we have postponed some projects at our Church building and Parish center that are currently required our attention. There is some considerable work to do to bring our buildings a reasonable standard so that it survives into the future and continues to serve as a place of worship and gathering of Gods people.

Here are some projects and estimated prices that we will start working in the near future:

PARISH HALL (we have a major leak in two restrooms and it's needs to be addressed ASAP)

- Remove and dispose of package unit and 3 condensers which are sitting on roof and no longer used - **\$16,800**
- Full Rip Off & Installation of Gaf Everguard Tpo Roofing System (20 years' warranty) - **\$67,000**

CHURCH BUILDING

- Interior Plaster Repair (removing and replacing damaged plaster from the rooms in choir loft) - **\$24,400**
- Interior Window Sill Repair - **\$7,000**
- Interior Tower Roof Patching - **\$6,800**
- Tower tops and decorative metal Repainting - **\$68,000** – this project is not a priority, but if we'll have enough funds we would like to get it done.

We are seeking your financial support towards these projects. We ask you to consider making a donation so we can move forward with this project.
