Available starting Sunday, November 29, at both St. Nicholas and St. Mary liturgies



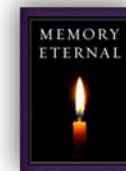
We are pleased to announce that St. Nicholas Church will be selling masks. The mask will be black with a gold Byzantine cross in the lower right corner of the mask.
