Privacy Notice

Introduction

This notice is to help you understand **how** and **why** we collect personal information about you and **what** we do with that information. It also explains the decision you can make about your own information.

What is "personal information"?

Personal information is information that identifies you as an individual and relates to you; this includes your name, address and telephone number, next of kin and health information.

Our legal basis for using your information

The Swimming Club is using your information when it is necessary for the Swimming Club's legitimate interests, except when your interests and fundamental rights override our legitimate interests.

Specifically, the Swimming Club has a legitimate interest in facilitating the efficient operation (welfare of its members) of the Swimming Club and ensuring that all relevant legal obligations of the swimming Club are complied with.

We shall use your information for the promotion of the Club. This includes any possible fundraising, using photographs of members at swimming events and for publication on our Facebook Group page.

Consent

We may ask for your consent to use your information in certain ways as an alternative to relying on the basis outlined above.

How long do we keep your information?

We keep information for as long as we need to, for the efficient operation of the Swimming Club. In exceptional circumstances, we may keep your information for a longer time than usual, but we would only do so if we had good reason and only if we are allowed to do so under the data protection law.

What decisions can you make about your information?

From the 25th May 2018 data protection legislation gave you some rights regarding your information. Some of these rights are new whilst others build on your existing rights. Your rights are as follows:

- **Rectification:** if the information is incorrect you can ask us to correct it.
- **Access:** you can also ask what information we hold about you and be provided with a copy. This is commonly known as making a Subject Access request.
- **Deletion:** you can ask us to delete the information we hold about you in certain circumstances. For example, where we no longer need the information.
- **Portability:** you can request the transfer of your information to you or a third party in a format that can be read by a computer.
- **Restriction:** our use of information about you may be restricted in some cases. For example, if you tell us the information is inaccurate we can only use it for limited purposes whilst we check its accuracy.

- **Object:** you may object to us using your information where we are using it for the direct marketing or similar purposes.

Types of personal data and why we process it (process means we obtain, store, update and delete data)

1. Name, address and telephone number of all members; to communicate with members.
2. Next of kin details; in case of emergency.
3. Health information; for the health and safety of members.

We will share your information with the Swimming Club Committee Members, Swimming Teachers and Lifeguards.

Membership of the Club is renewable each year. Your information will be collected and confidentially destroyed if your membership is not renewed.

If you are not happy or wish to raise a concern about our data processing you have the right to complain to Sedbergh Swimming Club in the first instance, to the Club's Data Protection Officer via email – Sedberghswimmingclub@gmail.com and we will do our best to resolve this.
