*August 16 Flea market in the park and **Survivor**

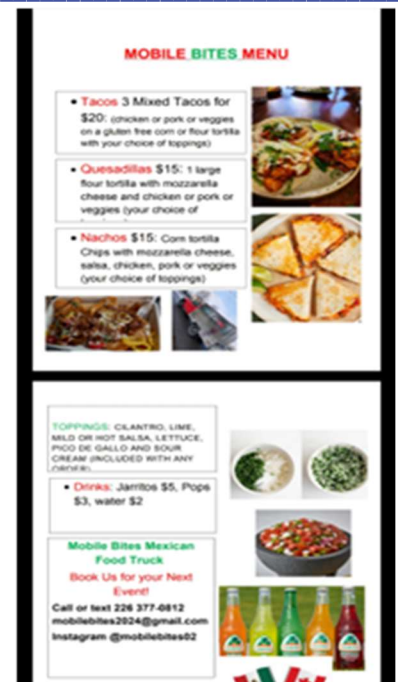

Tuesday & Wednesday: **CLOSED**

When there is no lifeguard on duty there is a maximum of 10 bathers in the pool enclosure. Please keep in mind that the lifeguarding schedule is weather dependant and may change without notice.

It is your responsibility to adhere to the capacity rules.

Adult swim times are daily noon-1pm and 5pm-6pm

The pool washrooms will be open and available the same hours as the pool.

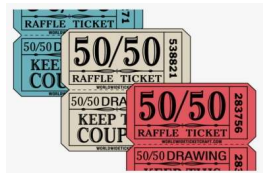

Good Reminders!

DUMP

Please keep dump area clean and tidy. If a bin is full, move onto and new one. DO NOT leave garbage on the ground, or on top of bins. Please DO NOT bring garbage from home.

Leaf pickup

Please place your leaf bags at the end of your site. Leaf pick up will be available until June 1st, after which time you will be responsible to take them to compost pile. Please remember that there is no fall leaf pickup. You must take your leaf bags to the compost in the fall, do not leave them on your site. **Paper bags only!**

Key Fobs

Seasonal guest key fobs are activated at the opening day of the park and work all year/ season.

If your fob did not work, it could for 1 of 2 reasons:

1. You have an outstanding balance on your account
2. You have 2 or more fobs under your name.

Golf Carts

If you have purchased a golf cart, please make sure to go to reception and ensure it is registered. A reminder that any newly purchased carts coming into the park must be electric. Gas golf carts are no longer permitted at Cedar cove and need to be removed from the property.

Boats

We are going to try our hardest to get the docks in for May 1st. But as of today the lake is still frozen and we still have lots of snow. Picture for reference!! Boats that are on your sites must be in the water no later than June 1st. All Boat trailers should be taken to the boat trailer storage (see map). Don't forget to get your tag to avoid being towed!



Registered family, guests, and service workers

All family, friends and service workers **MUST BE REGISTERED** prior to their arrival. If they are not registered and we cannot reach you they will be turned away.

There will be no charge for additional family or friends until Peak Season which is June 27th – Sept 2nd Season passes and coupons books are available through reception

Maximum 4 guests are permitted at a time above eligible family members.

Work orders & bill payment

Please call or email reception for any of your work order needs. Remember that **no digging** of any kind is permitted. Work orders will be filled out by staff and given to maintenance. We are usually pretty quick to get to these, but sometimes maintenance has other obligations so please be patient. **All charges are due now within 14 days of invoice date**

Boat/Utility Trailer Storage

Don't forget to come to reception to get your NEW tag for the 2025 season. Please remove all old tags as they are redundant. All boat/utility trailers must have a current tag to be stored in the storage area.

Get ready for a NEW Beach toy!!

Be prepared for an amazing surprise in time for Canada Day weekend!!

Please remember that lifejackets **MUST** be worn on the beach toys regardless of age or swimming ability.

Parents & Guardians must supervise children and be responsible for their safety.

Site Fees, Renewals, and customer portal

As you all know, we have been in the process of moving our renewal process to an online system. The process is now even easier! As you may remember, last year you had to sign the License of occupation in person one last time, allowing you to be able to just renew your contract online, as well as make payment, or see scheduled payments.

This year, you simply have to log in and renew! You will receive an email notifying you that you have a new reservation. This is for your 2026 season. This will have a different customer portal than your current reservation. When you follow the link it will take you to your 2026 booking. Here you will see your site fees, as well as our policies. In order to renew your contract, you must sign these policies online. Once you have signed, we will assume you are using the same payment schedule as last year (1 payment, 3 payments, or 12 payments). If you are making multiple instalments, we will go ahead and schedule your payments. Once this is done, you will receive an email notifying you that your renewal is complete. If you wish to change your payment type (3 payments, 12 payments or 1 payment), please notify us at your first convenience.

If you are intending to make one payment in full, you have until September 15th to do so, however if you renew (sign your policies on line and Pay in full) in the month of May you will receive a \$150 Credit that can be used in the 2026 season.

Reservation Credits no longer carry over so if you have one make sure you use it this year.

You will receive the email with your new reservation prior to opening day. Please take the time to read this email as it contains important information regarding your 2026 site fees.
