When there is no lifeguard on duty there is a maximum of 10 bathers in the pool **enclosure**. Please keep in mind that the lifeguarding schedule is weather dependant and may change without notice.

It is your responsibility to adhere to the capacity rules. The pool washrooms will be open and available the same hours as the pool.

# Good Reminders!

Please keep dump area clean and tidy. If a bin is full, move onto and new one. DO NOT leave garbage on the ground. Also, when driving to the dump, please be mindful of those campers that are on the main road to the dump. KEEP YOUR SPEED DOWN

#### Leaf pickup

Please place your leaf bags at the end of your site. Leaf pick up will be available until June 1<sup>st</sup>, after which time you will be responsible to take them to compost pile. Please remember that there is no fall leaf pickup. You must take your leaf bags to the compost in the fall, do not leave them on your site.

#### **Key Fobs**

Seasonal guest key fobs are activated at the opening day of the park and work all year/ season.

If your fob did not work, please go to reception.

\*Remember only principal occupant fobs are activated all season. Eligible family members need to be registered prior to their arrival for us to activate their fob.

#### **Golf Carts**

If you have purchased a golf cart, please make sure to go to reception and ensure it is registered. A reminder that any newly purchased carts coming into the park must be electric. All Golf carts must have working head lights and tail lights



#### **Boats**

Boats that are on your sites must be in the water no later than June 1<sup>st</sup>. All Boat trailers should go to the boat trailer storage (see map).



## Boat/Utility Trailer Storage

Boat and utility trailers will require storage tags. Boat trailers that do not have a current tag will be towed at the owner's expense. For guests who have already paid for 2024 boat/utility trailer storage please come to reception to get your tag!

## Work orders and firewood totes

Please call or email reception for any of your work order needs. Remember that no digging of any kind is permitted. Work orders will be filled out by staff and given to maintenance. We are usually pretty quick to get to these, but sometimes maintenance has other obligations so please be patient.

#### Registered family, guests, and service workers

All family, friends and service workers **MUST BE REGISTERED** prior to their arrival. If they are not registered and we cannot reach you they will be turned away.

There will be no charge for visitors until Peak Season which is June 27th – Sept 4<sup>th</sup> Season passes and coupons books are available through reception

## **Renewing for 2026**

# Pay in full for 2026 during May and receive a **\$150** reservation credit to use in your 2026 season!!


Simply log into your 2026 reservation portal and renew!

This is a different customer portal than your current reservation. Here you will see your site fees, as well as your renewal under the policies tab. To renew your contract, you **must** sign these policies online.

Once you have signed, we will assume you are using the same payment schedule as last year (1 payment, 3 payments, or 12 payments). If you are making multiple instalments, we will go ahead and schedule your payments.

Once this is done, you will receive an email notifying you that your renewal is complete. If you wish to change your payment type (3 payments, 12 payments or 1 payment), please notify us at your first convenience. If you are intending to make one payment in full, you have until September 15th to do so.

Reservation Credits no longer carry over so if you have one make sure you use it this year.
