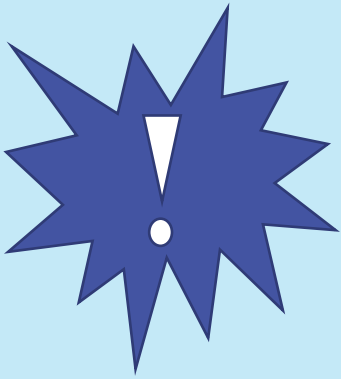

RECENT HIGHLIGHTS

As most of our guests already know, we have started the **p**roject of upgrading the electrical services in the park. This will be completed in 2 phases. The first phase is now complete. Each site has a new meter, new breakers and breaker panels have been installed in safe enclosures. Because we replaced the meters, a **h**ydro reading was taken prior to disconnecting the old meter. A bill has been generated for this hydro usage. This will mean that our guests will get 2 separate bills for the first hydro bill of the season, but they can both be paid in July. In the fall, we took the time to replace each and every tap. We hope that this helps our guests have a smoother and happier arrival to home away from home.

In the fall, we also made a massive upgrade to our parks septic system. Because of this, we had to move the location of the dump. The dump is now located at the west end of the park near boat trailer storage. We will continue to make it our priority to keep the dump clean and pest free, but ask that all of our guests do their part to help out when using the dump. Please make sure that the garbage makes it into the bin and not on the ground. If you notice that a bin is full, please use another, and do not pile garbage on top.

COVID 19 updates

We have all been working hard to stay safe, and keep our kids, friends, neighbors' and communities safe for over a year now. Although we have made some progress, we are not out of the woods yet. We still have some restrictions and guidelines that we need to follow. We understand how difficult this is on everyone and we want to thank you for all of your cooperation and support. Once Ontario is 60% Vaccinated, we can move into phase 1 of reopening the province. This means exciting things like patio dining, and many other great things that we have missed so much! Because of the current restrictions, guests are only able to have members of the same household to the site. This unfortunately means no visitors for the time being.

Boats

The docks are in the water! Please remember that this means your boat should be in the water and not on your site. Boat trailers should be taken to the boat trailer storage (see map).

Golf Carts

If you have purchased a golf cart, please make sure to go to reception and ensure it is registered. A reminder that any newly purchased carts coming into the park must be electric.

Key Fobs

Seasonal guest key fobs are activated at the opening day of the park and work all year. If your fob did not work, it could be 1 of 2 reasons:

- 1- You have an outstanding balance on your account
- 2- You had 2 or more fobs under your name.

Please remember fobs are for you and you only. Never share your fob with anyone. Service workers, guests, family, friends etc. all **MUST BE REGISTERED** prior to arriving. If necessary, reception will issue a key fob for the length of their stay.

Work orders and firewood totes

Please call or email reception for any of your work order needs. Remember that no digging of any kind is permitted. Work orders will be filled out by staff and given to maintenance. We are usually pretty quick to get to these, but sometimes maintenance has other obligations so please be patient. Firewood totes are still available for delivery. Please call reception to make arrangements

Hydro Bills

Hydro meters are read at the beginning of July and the beginning of September. Please remember that this year, your first hydro bill will consist of 2 readings. One reading was taken before your old hydro meter was disconnected, and the next on the new meter. These bills can be paid as one total. Please remember that payment is due on any charge a maximum of 30 days after invoicing. Any payments over 30 days due will incur 3% late fee monthly, and key fobs will be disabled until payment in full is made.



Remember that Ontario bylaw states that any cyclist under the age of 18 must wear a helmet. Parents, please make sure that when kids are on their bikes, that they are wearing a helmet. ABSOLUTELY NO biking allowed on concrete walkways at the lodge or on the patio.

Golf Carts

Although golf carts are a fun and easy way to get around the park, they are still a vehicle and need to be treated with the same safety precautions. Remember driving a golf cart under the influence is against the law, and dangerous to you, and those around you. Cedar Cove Resort is making the transition to an all-electric golf cart policy. Those of our guests who have a gas-powered cart do not have to rush out and buy an electric cart but we do ask any new carts coming into the park are electric.

Having electric carts only keeps our kids, dogs and ourselves safer from incident. Not only are electric powered carts better for our environment, they are quieter, and much safer. By 2025 Cedar Cove Resort will have an all-electric cart policy. Please remember that all golf carts must be insured, and proof of insurance must be kept on file with reception. Please register your new golf carts at reception.

Please be mindful of the 15km/hr speed limit.
