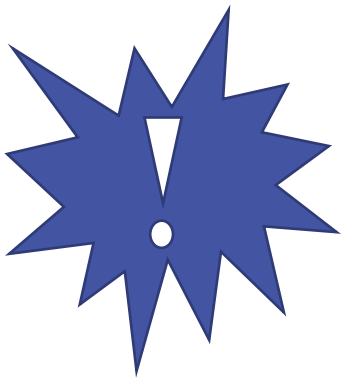
### Leaf pickup

## COVID 19 updates

## 50/50

## Boats

Docks are in. Boats that are on your sites must be in the water no later than June 1. All boat trailers should be taken to the boat trailer storage (see map).

## Golf Carts

If you have purchased a golf cart, please make sure to go to reception and ensure it is registered. A reminder that any newly purchased carts coming into the park must be electric. Remember that by 2025 all golfs carts at Cedar Cove must be electric.

## Key Fobs

Seasonal guest key fobs are activated at the opening day of the park and work all year. If your fob did not work, it could 1 of 2 reasons:

- 1- You have an outstanding balance on your account
- 2- You had 2 or more fobs under your name.

Please remember fobs are for you and you only. Never share your fob with anyone. Service workers, guests, family, friends etc. all **MUST BE REGISTERED** prior to arriving. If necessary, reception will issue a key fob for the length of their stay.

## Work orders and firewood totes

Please call or email reception for any of your work order needs. Remember that no digging of any kind is permitted. Work orders will be filled out by staff and given to maintenance. We are usually pretty quick to get to these, but sometimes maintenance has other obligations so please be patient. Firewood totes are still available for delivery. Please call reception to make arrangements

### POOL AND BEACH AREA

Please remember that children under the age of 12 cannot be in the pool enclosure unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. Please remember that you are responsible to watch your children while at the beach or using the inflatable beach toys. The beach is open after sunrise and until sunset. The beach toys will be installed for July 1<sup>st</sup> weekend.

The pool will be opening May long weekend



Remember that Ontario bylaw states that any cyclist under the age of 18 must wear a helmet. Parents, please make sure that when kids are on their bikes, that they are wearing a helmet.

**ABSOLUTELY NO** biking allowed on concrete walkways at the lodge or on the patio.

### DUMP

Please keep dump area clean and tidy. If a bin is full, move onto a new one. **DO NOT** leave garbage on the ground. Also, when driving to the dump, please be mindful of those campers that are on the main road to the dump. **KEEP YOUR SPEED DOWN**
