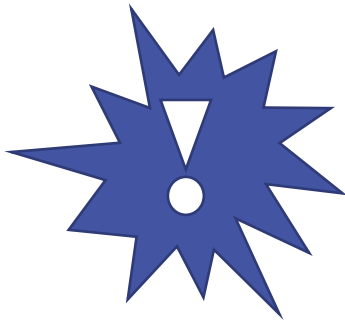

## Pool

The Pool Will be open daily from  
10am-8pm.

Please go to the store to reserve a swim  
time.

After an overwhelming request from guests last season, we have created a swim sign-up by appointment. Despite being requested, this seems to also be a point of frustration for some guests. Cedar Cove continues to search for lifeguards everyday. Unfortunately due to the pandemic, recertifications are extremely backlogged making lifeguards very difficult to find. We kindly ask you to be patient. Aggression towards the store staff or any CCR employee will NOT BE TOLERATED.

Pool sign ups can NO longer be made  
more than 48 hours in advance.

A reminder that adult swim times are from  
12pm-1pm and 5pm-6pm daily.

## Beach

The beach is open sunup to sundown. Please use the beach and aquaglide inflatable water toys at your own risk. The beach is NOT lifeguarded, and all children must be supervised by an adult. Lifejackets must be worn while using beach toys.

Absolutely no fishing or motorized vessels  
inside the cribbed area.

Dogs must use the dog beach directly beside  
the beach.

No glass containers permitted on the beach.  
Please use beach toys as intended. Climbing  
on or flipping of beach toys could result in  
damage to the toys, and could mean having  
to remove them.

## Golf Carts

If you have purchased a golf cart, please make sure to go to reception and ensure it is registered. A reminder that any newly purchased carts coming into the park must be **electric**. Remember that by 2025 all golf carts at Cedar Cove must be electric.

Only licensed drivers are permitted to operate golf carts on Cedar Cove property.

## Key Fobs

Seasonal guest key fobs are activated on the opening day of the park and work all year. if your fob did not work, it could be 1 of 2 reasons:

1. You have an outstanding balance on your account
2. You have two or more fobs under your name

Please remember that fobs are for you and for you only. Never share your fob with anyone. Service workers, friends, guests, etc. MUST BE REGISTERED prior to their arrival. If necessary, reception will issue a fob for the length of their stay.

## Canada Day Weekend

To celebrate the beautiful country we live in, we will be hosting some events around the park.

**Friday July 1<sup>st</sup>:** Richmond Ramblers will be playing at Smith's Beach before and after the fireworks. Fireworks will be at dusk.

**Saturday July 2<sup>nd</sup>:** The Canada Day Golf Cart and Bicycle Parade will take place at 2:00pm. Participants are to meet up by the Imagination Station.

Rainman will be playing at the Imagination Station at 7:00pm. Bring your lawn chairs and enjoy an evening of live music in the park!

## Firewood Totes and Work Orders

Please call or email reception for any of your work order needs. Remember that no digging of any kind is permitted. Work orders will be filled out by staff and given to maintenance. We are usually pretty quick to get to these, but sometimes maintenance has other obligations, so please be patient. Firewood totes are still available for delivery. Please call reception to make arrangements.

## **Family Bingo**

Family Bingo will take place on Saturdays at 6:30pm in the pavilion. Please bring small bills to bingo. Children are more than welcome to accompany parents at bingo. Bingo will also take place on Sundays of long weekends. Canada day weekend will only have a Saturday bingo.

## **Bikes**

Remember that Ontario bylaw states that any cyclist under the age of 18 must wear a helmet. Parents, please make sure that when kids are on their bikes, they are wearing a helmet. ABSOLUTELY NO biking allowed on concrete walkways at the lodge or on the patio.

## **Dump**

Please keep dump area clean and tidy. If a bin is full, move onto a new one. **DO NOT** leave garbage on the ground. **DO NOT DISPOSE OF PROPANE TANKS IN THE DUMPSTERS. It is a severe fire hazard. PLEASE BRING THEM TO THE STORE FREE OF CHARGE.** Also, when driving to the dump, please be mindful of those campers that are on the main road to the dump.

## **Cedar Cove's 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Golf Tournament**

On July 09 at 10:30 AM (rain or shine), Cedar Cove will be hosting its annual Mixed Golf Tournament at Mountain Creek Golf Course on White Lake Rd. Last year's tourney was another huge success where we had 40 golfers participate. The format for this tournament is 4 ball best ball, so you don't have to be a regular golfer to have fun. Once again, this year we have room for up to 40, so please contact tournament organizers Mario and Diana at site G-24 to register your teams or to sign up as golfer to be placed on a team. Tournament organizers reserve the right to change members of teams to make this tournament as fun and fair as possible. Post game awards will be done at the Mountain Creek GC clubhouse. Cedar Cove Resort will still be donating prizes for the winning teams (Men & Mixed), Ladies and Men's longest drive and Ladies and Men's closest to the pin. Furthermore, there will be miscellaneous prizes awarded through random draws as well as prizes for most honest golfers. Cost for this tourney is \$45 for shared cart to be paid in advance upon registration at site G-24.

## **Bocce Ball Tournament**

As per every long weekend on July 02 (or July 03 if rain is forecast), there will be another Bocce Ball tournament alongside the beach. This is an adult only tournament where, this time, teams will be made up by choosing your own partner. The tourney is a double knockout format meaning each team will play a minimum of two games. Entry fee is \$5 per person with all the monies being returned for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Registration starts at 9:00am at the Bocce Courts and the tournament starts at 10:00am sharp. This is strictly a fun tourney and gives an opportunity for all guests to meet others and enjoy a full day of fun. Organizers for this event are Mike Leger and Doug Cook.
