

Privacy Policy

Effective Date: March 1, 2026

This Privacy Policy describes how Eight 31 Capital ("we," "us," or "our") handles information in connection with ATLAS — our internal Accounting, Treasury, Ledger & Administration System.

1. Scope

ATLAS is a proprietary, internal-use application operated exclusively by Eight 31 Capital employees and authorized personnel. It is not available to the general public.

2. Information We Access

In connection with QuickBooks Online integration, ATLAS may access the following data through the Intuit QuickBooks API on behalf of authorized users:

- Chart of accounts and account balances
- Invoices, bills, and transaction records
- Vendor and customer contact information
- Company financial reports

3. How We Use Information

Data accessed through the QuickBooks API is used solely for internal accounting, treasury, and reporting functions within Eight 31 Capital. We do not sell, rent, or share this data with any third parties.

4. Data Storage

Operational data is stored locally on Eight 31 Capital systems and synchronized via Box Drive. No financial data is transmitted to external servers beyond the authorized Intuit API endpoints.

5. Data Retention

Data is retained for as long as necessary to fulfill internal accounting obligations and applicable regulatory requirements. Users may request data removal by contacting the system administrator.

6. Security

Access to ATLAS is restricted to authenticated Eight 31 Capital personnel. OAuth 2.0 is used for QuickBooks API authorization. Credentials are never stored in plaintext.

7. Third-Party Services

ATLAS integrates with Intuit QuickBooks Online. Use of QuickBooks is subject to Intuit's Privacy Statement (intuit.com/privacy/statement).
