The aim of Project NETT is to improve outcomes for children from birth to six years of age at significant risk of developing, showing early signs of, or having been diagnosed with a serious emotional disturbance (SED), including children with a history of in-utero exposure to substances that may impact development, and those from marginalized immigrant and BIPOC communities. by developing, maintaining, and enhancing infant and early childhood mental health intervention and treatment services.
