Scholarship recipients are required to provide official documentation of FAMU admission or a pending FAMU application; provide 2 letters of recommendation and submit an essay on one of the following topics.

- ✦ Describe ways agriculture can benefit your local community.

- Application** – Enclose your completed and signed application form.
- High School or College Transcript** – Attach a copy of your transcript.
- SAT or ACT Scores if a graduating high school senior**
- Essay** – Include a 300 to 500-word essay addressing one of the topics below:
 - How do you foresee agriculture playing a role in your career path?
 - Describe ways agriculture can benefit your local community.
- Two Letters of Support** – Attach two letters of recommendation: from a high school or college counselor, advisor, administrator or professor or a mentor, or community leader that can address your character, capabilities, and community involvement.
- FAMU – Acceptance Confirmation** - Attach a copy of your Acceptance Letter from FAMU; or
- FAMU – Admission Pending** - Attach a copy of FAMU Confirming receipt of your application.

Please note that the Scholarship Committee may request an interview with you as part of the application process. Disclaimer: Scholarship award is contingent upon acceptance to Florida A & M University; Scholarship recipient must maintain full-time enrollment status throughout the duration of the scholarship award.
