SO WHAT IS THE WARREN COUNTY REPUBLICAN CENTRAL COMMITTEE?

The general management of the affairs of the Republican Party in Warren County is vested in the Warren County Republican Central Committee. The Central Committee consists of two representatives from each of Warren County's 40 precincts. Each precinct elects two Central Committee members at the biannual caucus.

SO WHAT WILL I BE DOING AS A CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEMBER?

In general: Working to promote the Republican cause and helping to elect Republicans!

Specifically:

1. Volunteer and recruit other volunteers for parades, county events, election activities, and precinct caucuses.
2. Work with your other precinct member to get to know your neighbors - then get them involved!
3. Represent your precinct by attending monthly Warren County Republican meetings.
4. Encourage Republicans to get out and vote!
