#### **Opening a Bank Account**

A bank account can be opened in the name of an individual singly or jointly with a family member by submitting the following documents: Passport size photographs Identity proof Address proof Opening amount Once the account is opened, the bank provides to the account holder an account number and cheque book to operate the account. Some banks also provide account holders with access to mobile banking.



#### **Types of Bank Accounts**

**Savings Account:** These are the accounts opened in banks with the key purpose of inculcating the habit of saving among people. This kind of account is popular with students, salaried individuals, and senior citizens. Savings accounts earn a nominal interest which is based on the time period the funds are parked in the account.

**Current Account:** These accounts are opened by business owners as they meet their requirement for an unlimited number of cash deposits and withdrawals.

**Fixed Deposit:** This account type is ideal for depositors who wish to park their funds in the bank for a long period of time. The key benefit of fixed deposit is that it provides a substantially higher rate of interest compared to savings accounts.

**Recurring Deposit:** Very popular with students, recurring deposits are designed to encourage the habit of regular savings among people. These deposits higher interest than savings accounts.

#### **The Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award**

The Khel Ratna Award, officially known as the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award, is the highest sporting honor in India. It is awarded annually by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.



#### **The Arjuna Awards**

officially known as Arjuna Awards, given for Outstanding Performance in Sports and Games, are the second-highest sporting honor in India, the highest being the Major Dhyan Chand Khel Ratna Award. The award is named after Arjuna, one of the characters in the Sanskrit epic Mahabharata of ancient India.

#### **The Dronacharya Award**

Officially known as the Dronacharya Award for Outstanding Coaches in Sports and Games, is a sports coaching honor of the Republic of India. The award is named after Drona, often referred to as "Dronacharya" or "Guru Drona", a character from the Sanskrit epic Mahabharata of ancient India.

#### **BCCI** Awards

The BCCI Awards are a set of annual cricket awards given by the Board of Control for Cricket in India. The awards recognize and honor the best Indian international and domestic cricketers for the past year. The awards were first given in 2006–07.

#### Maulana Abul Kalam Azad (MAKA) Trophy 2023

The oldest National Sports Award in India, the Maulana Abul Kalam Azad Trophy or the MAKA Trophy, was instituted in 1956–1957. This award is named in honor of the Indian freedom fighter and the country's first education minister, Shri Abul Kalam Azad.


Abbakka organized an army against repeated Portuguese naval attacks and forged alliances with nearby rulers.
