A Glimpse of Key GI4QC Events of Previous Quarter

9 Apr 2025 - Webinar of GI4QC Forum

Samskruth Sanganakam (Sanskrit Computer)

GI4QC Forum hosted an insightful presentation by Dr. BVK Sastry on the "Development of Panini Samskrutham Language Model for Conversational AI" (Samskrut Sanganakam).

Quoting various examples and references he explained the need for Samskruth Language Tech AI Design. The world is moving towards conversational AI. However, the current technology is a script oriented integration model which is not suitable for spoken language systems. The existing Sanskrit AI solutions neither help realise the full potential benefit of AI nor do they preserve the essence of the knowledge contained in the ancient texts.

He further presented his thoughts on how to rectify this situation. He argued that AI technology is not language neutral and the need of the hour is a technology which is language appropriate. Language model choice matching is critical for efficient AI. He therefore suggested that Indian AI tech solutions need design thinking implementation by native natural LLMs of Indian Languages.

He warned that the current design thinking is giving rise to the techno-colonisation of global languages. It is important that we develop solutions that cater to the nuances of all Indian languages while developing Conversational AI because cultural death begins with voluntary surrender of language identity.

Indian Knowledge: Insights & Applications

GI4QC Forum hosted its 30th monthly webinar last week - an insightful presentation by Mr. Ajay Chaturvedi on "Time" in our series - "Indian Knowledge: Insights & Applications".

Time, in today's scientific context, is a measurement of duration between two events. A few centuries ago we fixed a time "zero" on the calendar, fixed each day as 24 hours, each hour as 60 minutes, each minute as 60 seconds and so on. And the entire world started aligning to these "mechanised" concepts without questioning the rationale behind them. While the "standardization" of clock and calendar is helpful in today's world as everyone is following the same system, it has led to a situation wherein people have started aligning their lives to the clock and the calendar rather than the time.

Ancient Indic texts define time using concepts like sunrise, our position with respect to the constellations, lunar day etc. The Time or "Kaala" is not an independent concept; it is not as if it is running elsewhere and we are here. We are moving along with time. This concept needs to be appreciated with an independent, objective, critical mind. Anything that we don't understand is not necessarily mythical. And if we understand how to align ourselves with time or tune into time, the quality of our lives will improve. Aligning our activities to sunrise rather than the clock (say, 6:00 am), to the season rather than the calendar (summer vs. May or June) is what these ancient texts teach us.

The day humanity understands this, our science, our innovations and our life will become more in tune with nature.

The disconnect of Voice and grammar- communication-processing by Panini frame work is staring clear. My endeavour traces the legacy roots of above gaps in Samskruth - Language - Technology to improper adoption of Panini - Shiva Sutras listed Human voice character set (= Varna- Akshara - Samaamnaaya) - Processes for programmatic interfacing algorithms (Prakriyaa- Sutra- Niyama- Vidhi).

The team needs to be made from Tech- language Designers (like the ones who developed languages like C, Java, ..) and Samskruth Grammarians who can interpret Panini Sutras as ' Voiced Communication - Cognitive linguistic Processing in live human conversation. - I am trying brainwave (EEG) measurement through BioAmp sensor and Audrino with Spike Recorder Software in Windows (with FFT on). I was able to observe sort of synchronized dominating waves during relaxing meditation as alpha and theta mostly (4-12 Hz).
