Many calendars, One Cosmos: Bharatiya ways of time keeping

In this webinar (hosted by Anand Prakash, Guest of Honor Prof. (Dr.) Vinay Vidyalkar, panelists Dasari Narasimha and Kaudinya Arpan) it was noted that various communities followed their own system of time keeping due to their own historical reasons and we should not be too obsessed with the question of which traditional calendar system is the best.

The common characteristics of most Indic calendar systems is that they are primarily lunisolar, combining both lunar months and a solar year. While months are calculated based on the moon's phases, the year is aligned with the sun's journey by inserting an extra month every 2.5–3 years to keep the seasons aligned. A point to be remembered here is that not all traditional calendars are

lunisolar. Some use solar transitions for months instead of lunar months.

These systems, which follow the astronomical events to track the passage of time, have been in use from much before the current Gregorian calendar system. They have been our guides for centuries and have helped us align our activities with the cyclic events of nature and, thus, were helpful in maximizing our well-being. For example, aligning the sowing of crops with a specific time period in a particular season, increased the probability of good agriculture produce (though it did not guarantee the same).

The speakers emphasized that we should not confuse correlation with causation.

Most of us have, unfortunately, reduced the traditional study of celestial events to astrology, using it as a tool to predict the future and to avoid difficult times by restoring to "upaaye". We need to appreciate that our traditional calendar systems are essentially

tools to track time and select the most appropriate time for an activity so as to improve our chances of success. They are not a tool to predict/change our future.

Just like modern medical science prescribes when a particular pill should be taken to maximize its effectiveness (consuming it at a different time will reduce its effectiveness but not eliminate it), similarly, traditional knowledge systems equip us with the know-how of aligning our actions with the cycles of nature to improve the chances of success.

6 May 2026 – 41st Monthly Webinar of GI4QC Forum

Manifestation of Conscious Intent in the Physical World - 2

On 25th Feb Dr. Anoop Kumar, Mr. Naresh Iyer, Dr. Sohom Chakrabarty & Prof. (Dr.) J P Dudeja shared some thoughts on this topic. But, instead of quenching our curiosity, they fanned it further. We, therefore, met again on 6th May to dive deeper into this topic.

We know that the act of observation collapses the wave function resulting in

observation of a particle. This implies that the act of observation influences the physical world in some manner. The question that we wanted to explore is whether we can use the power of mind (conscious intent) to influence the physical world as per our wish or desire or instruction. Can we design some experiments to study on how intention and attention works. Can we create some technologies which can leverage this power of mind.

Dr. Sohom Chakrabarty used the concepts from Sankhya Darshan, three gunas and three bodies to present a framework and dived deep into how this framework holds clues for understanding the mechanics of manifestation of a thought held by a conscious being. Thereafter, Kamendra Kumar ji, the Guest of Honor, shared his powerful thoughts on the Indic wisdom and the Consciousness-First Worldview.

We invite you to watch this 20 minutes presentation and the subsequent open

discussion wherein we collectively tried to explore the topic further.

One unanswered question to be taken up in the followup session is "where do we draw a line between manifestation and confirmation bias". This question demands more clarity if we want to design experiments to verify the framework shared by Dr. Sohom Chakrabarty or want to develop technologies for leveraging the power of conscious intent.

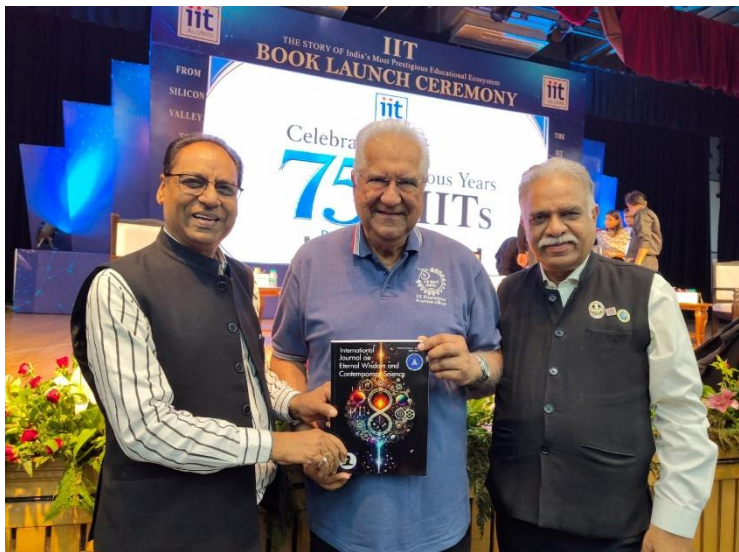

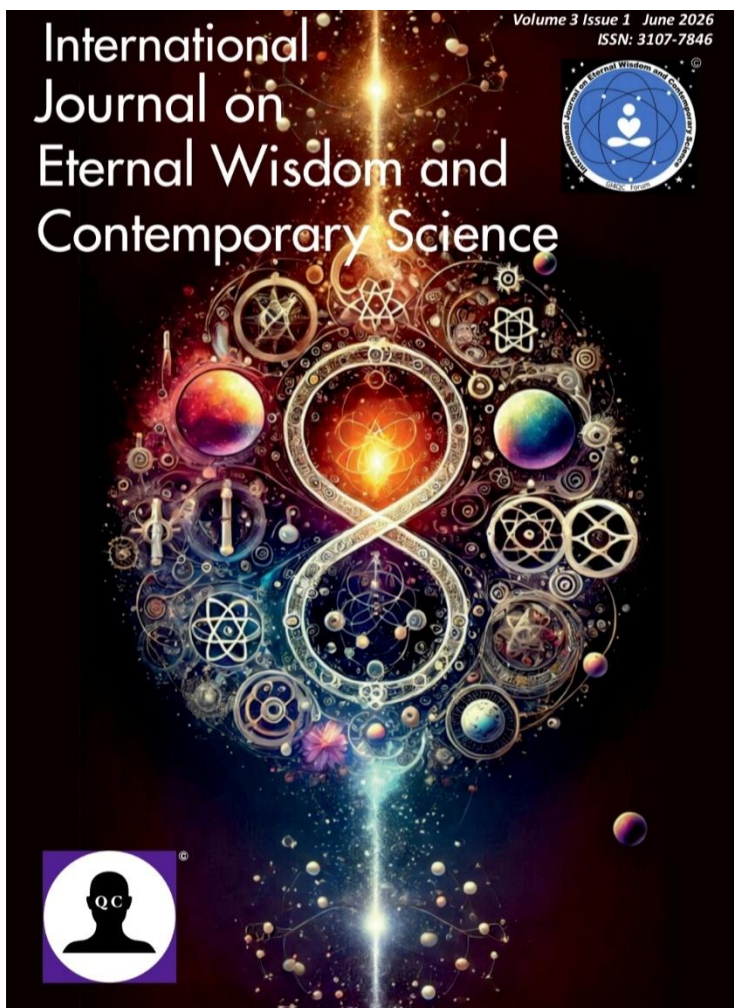

Indian Knowledge Insights and Applications (IKIA): Happiness Index

We had a very thought-provoking conversation on Happiness Index at GI4QC Forum recently. The focus was on Indian Knowledge Insights and Applications in the context of Happiness. We all know that India ranks very low in this ranking system. But does this index truly reflect the ground realities? The parameters used to gauge happiness levels include GDP per Capita, Social Support, Healthy Life Expectancy, Freedom to Make Life Choices, Generosity and Perceptions of Corruption.

Are these parameters sufficient to measure happiness? Most people are leading a very individual centric or anthropocentric life. Steady economic growth and instant gratification have become synonyms of happiness. But are such individuals truly

happy? If yes, then why is there an increase in mental health issues? Why is loneliness on rise? Why are the 'happy' societies disintegrating? Does achievement and accumulation necessarily translate into happiness? Or is there something that we are missing?

The panelists were of the opinion that there is a need to broaden our perspective and be as concerned about the well-being of the community, the environment and the planet as we are of ourselves and our families.

The timeless Indic insights on happiness contains many ideas which must be understood and adopted in words and spirit. This includes concepts like

- Sukha - auspicious/harmonious spaces - personal space, collective space, professional space, physical space, mental space...
- Hita - concern/desire for well-being of everyone and everything including all living creatures

- Santosh - the sense of sufficiency and contentment
- Aparigraha - the virtue of non-attachment and non-greed
- R̥ta - it represents standards for human righteousness, honesty, and justice
- R̥ṇa - the obligations an individual is born with and must repay to cosmic powers, ancestors, teachers, society, all living creatures and nature
- Yajna - acts directed to the welfare of others, done without desiring any return for it
- Bṛhat - embodies magnitude, strength, and expansiveness, and is frequently used to denote something of primary importance or large scale
- Dharma - cosmic order, righteous conduct, moral duty, or the natural way of being that upholds the universe and society

Embracing and incorporating these concepts will help us lead a happy and fulfilling life. This leaves us with another question - How do we measure and rank this Indic definition

of Happiness? Or will there be any need left to measure and compare ourselves after we adopt this inclusive and all-encompassing way of living?

Thank you Prof. Girishwar Misra, Prof. Mala Kapadia , Dr. Anuradha Choudry and Anand Prakash for initiating this discussion. Looking forward to your continued guidance as we together explore how to popularise their adoption across the world.

THE PRINCIPLE OF PSYCHOLOGICAL RELATIVITY

A FRAMEWORK LINKING GRAVITY, SELF-REGISTRATION, DESIRE AND POSITIONAL CONSCIOUSNESS

Matter curves spacetime. Registration curves mind-space.
Movement follows the curvature created by the center.

PHYSICAL REALITY (Relativity)

Mass-Energy curves spacetime

↓

Spacetime tells matter how to move

PSYCHOLOGICAL REALITY (Mind)

Registration (memory, identification, self-reference) curves mind-space

Mind-space tells thoughts how to move

TWO DOMAINS ONE PRINCIPLE

CENTERS CREATE CURVATURE

1. REGISTRATION: THE ORIGIN

Experience → Registration → Memory → Identity → Desire

WITNESSING & CONTROL

I can witness thoughts, emotions, and sensations.
But witnessing = control.
Control is limited by existing curvature.

POSITIONAL COMFORT

The mind seeks familiar, stable positions.
Comfort is psychological equilibrium within existing curvature.
