From the Editor's Desk

Dear Friends,

Warm greetings from the GI4QC Forum.

We have the pleasure of presenting the **Eighth Edition of the GI4QC Forum's Quarterly Update**. The issue brings out the width and depth of the discourses during this quarter. The use of ancient knowledge system in the field of Psychology, exploring manifestation of conscious intent in the physical world, the practice of Yoga Nidra and study of brain activity during Nidra, and leveraging Indic wisdom for corporate excellence are some highlights of this quarter.

There is a global interest in integrating traditional knowledge system with modern education framework. Universities worldwide offer courses on Yoga and meditation (rooted in Yoga Sutras of Patanjali), Indian philosophy and ethical reasoning, mental health & emotional controls – a living proof of

increasing interest in interdisciplinary and sustainability studies inspired by Indian thought. Concepts from the Bhagavad Gita are widely used in leadership training. Indian ecological philosophies which emphasize harmony with nature inspire sustainable development initiatives across various sectors. Traditional knowledge is often difficult to formalize. Some areas require more empirical research for global acceptance.

Cultural concepts like World Women's-day, World Earth-day, World Wild-life-day which were celebrated during this quarter may be oversimplified globalized event but are embedded in Indian culture under different nomenclature. The content rich ancient knowledge system needs strong narrative for acceptance in the new scientific world. We are moving in the right direction but the effort and speed needs to be increased in geometrical progression.

The world is navigating a period of profound uncertainty, marked by geopolitical tensions, economic fragility and humanitarian challenges. The international landscape

between January and April 2026 reflects both the vulnerabilities and resilience of the global order. Geopolitical conflict in the Middle East has ripple effects across the globe. It has heightened security concerns and also disrupted global energy markets. Ongoing Russia–Ukraine war, now entering another prolonged phase, has strained international diplomacy and tests the effectiveness of multilateral institutions. The persistence of violence in regions such as Sudan, Lebanon, Palestine, Iran highlights the urgent need for sustained humanitarian intervention and conflict resolution mechanisms. As we reflect on these developments, a central theme emerges: the need for renewed global cooperation.

Indian Knowledge Insights and Applications in the field of Psychology

GI4QC Forum recently organised its 37th monthly webinar moderated by Anand Prakash. Prof (Dr.) Anviti Gupta (Dean & Professor of Psychology at Sharda School of Humanities and Social Sciences) and Bindu Joshi ji (Psychotherapist, author and social worker) shared insights on how Indic

Knowledge can be applied in the field of Psychology.

A person is defined by how he/she processes and perceives things. Perception defines one's thoughts which, in turn, defines one's behaviour. In recent times we can notice a substantial decline in people's ability to process their perception and thoughts which is slowly transforming into a wide range of mental health issues.

Psychology is the huge, deep and complex science of human and animal behaviour including the reasons behind their behaviour as well as its consequences.

The frameworks of *triguna*, *tridosha*, and *panchkosha* from ancient Indic texts equip you with an understanding of yourself and your place in this universe. They integrate experience, ethics and interconnectedness for real well-being and are extremely useful in developing resilience. *Mahavakya* like "*Aham Brahmasmi*" remind you that you

have unlimited potential within you. In fact, if everyone in the society adopts a disciplined life by balancing the four *purusharth*, then our environment itself would become therapeutic leading to minimal mental health issues.

The need of the hour is to focus on emotional literacy with the aim to empower people to cope with life situations without impacting their mental well-being. If this implies that every individual should invest time to gain some basic knowledge of Psychology then so be it.

Spirituo-Scientific Worldview: From the Shadows to the Spotlight

Leveraging Indic Wisdom for Corporate Excellence

GI4QC Forum hosted an engaging webinar titled "Leveraging Indic Wisdom for Corporate Excellence". The conversation centered around the hurdles encountered in adopting Indic Wisdom for designing reliable and sustainable solutions to the challenges and situations in the corporate world.

All the participants were of the view that the most effective way forward is to contextualise and contemporise the Indic concepts of purpose, meaning and non-doership and integrate them with selected western management frameworks that focus on growth and sustainability. These integrated frameworks would help create a nurturing

environment enabling both individual as well as corporate development.

While some participants felt that the key challenge lies in motivating the younger generation to explore IKS inspired frameworks, the younger participants opined that the main obstacle is the absence of easily accessible ready-to-use roadmaps to resolve or circumvent the day-to-day problems of running a business.

Indic Wisdom, by design, does not provide one-size-fits-all models and expects that each individual possesses some basic understanding of the available roadmaps so that they can opt for the most appropriate one after due diligence. However, the current generation wants ease-of-use even if it implies selecting a less optimal approach.

Another hurdle in leveraging Indic Wisdom for Corporate Excellence is the lack of evidence-based frameworks.

All these issues cannot be resolved overnight. We require a comprehensive multifaceted approach which we will identify in the followup sessions of this series of webinars titled "Spirituo-Scientific Domain: From the Shadows to the Spotlight".
