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## 29 Oct 2025 - Webinar of GI4QC Forum

### Agnostic, Atheist, or Awakened? Youth Defining the Spirituo-Scientific Domain

GI4QC Forum hosted the 34th monthly webinar where three representatives from our Youth Brigade, “Pioneers of Tomorrow”, shared their views. All the panellists said that they were atheist however now their perspective has changed. They cannot call themselves as awakened yet but they are certain that there is some intelligent power in this universe. They were quick to add that accepting this intelligent power does not imply that they are now theist. Everyone accepted that exposure to spiritual concepts of IKS helped them understand their inner world and potential and gave them the confidence and equanimity to face the ups and downs of life. The panellists spoke about their life journeys and told how Indic wisdom and insights helped them in navigating

through the difficult phases of their lives – a medical condition wherein the doctors estimated that he has only a few more months left; failure in qualifying for the dream career despite repeated attempts; a ‘successful’ corporate job, however, life still seemed ‘empty’.

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## **7 Nov 2025 - BHAAGYA Session at IIT Roorkee**

There is a need to remove the negative bias that the younger generation has for Indic Knowledge. Despite a mandate to HEIs to include IKS courses and despite a keen interest by professors to impart this knowledge, the majority of the students do not appreciate the need for these courses. They believe that Indic Knowledge does not help them get jobs and hence it is of no significance.

GI4QC Forum, through its BHAAGYA (Bharatiya Gyana Anuragi) Program, has been working to remove this prejudice. On 7 Nov, Ms Devika Kumari, a young entrepreneur associated with GI4QC Forum, had an opportunity to interact directly with students at IIT Roorkee (thanks to Dr Sohom Chakraborty). We are happy to share that the session was received well by the students.

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## **19 Nov 2025 - Webinar of GI4QC Forum**

### **Spirituo-Scientific Worldview: From the Shadows to the Spotlight**

### **Indic Wisdom – Towards a More Informed and Inclusive Narrative**

Many individuals and organisations are vociferously supporting IKS and there are numerous entities working tirelessly at the grassroots with a vision to bring this timeless knowledge back into the mainstream.

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However, the impact at national and international level is far from satisfactory. The usefulness of adopting the Indic way of life has to be pointed out not just to school and college students but also to the larger community. A conducive ecosystem has to be created. And instead of waiting for state or national policies to guide us, we have to continue redefining and refining our approaches and continue moving closer towards our shared dream.

The third episode of "Spirituos-Scientific Domain: From the Shadows to the Spotlight" was a step in this direction. Multiple suggestions were put forward like creating a structured framework, designing age-wise action plan, focussing on experiential learning (*panchkosh*, *swabhava*, *swadharma...*), having dedicated IKS guide/teachers in educational institutions, creating culture waterholes, disseminating Indic knowledge outside the structured education system, leveraging social media, using local language and examples, adopting

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student-centric approach instead of "one size fits all" and so on.

Everyone agreed that IKS should be an integral part of the structured framework of education, taught more as a life skill rather than a separate subject. Everyone also recognised that there is a risk that efforts to mainstream Indic Wisdom or IKS can be mistaken as a religious or a political agenda. It was also felt that instead of discussing the challenges of introducing IKS at schools, the Forum should now get into execution mode and start exploring synergies which can be leveraged for wider impact.

minded individuals and organisations and make this Forum a platform to connect, explore and build synergies to strengthen ongoing individual and joint initiatives in the Spirituo-Scientific Domain.
