Graduates who are currently enrolled in, or plan to enroll in a **university, college, community college, or accredited trade school** are eligible to apply for a Cambridge Commercial Club Scholarship.

Graduates meeting at least one of the following three criteria are eligible to apply:

- I am a 2026 graduate of Cambridge High School, Midvale High School, or Homeschool: _____
- I am a 2026 graduating dependent of a current Cambridge Commercial Club member (regardless of where I live)
CCC Member Name: _____
- I have previously received a CCC scholarship and am still enrolled in a university, college, community college, or accredited trade school.
Most recent year I was awarded a CCC Scholarship: _____

Application deadline is May 1, 2026 and must include:

- ★ An error free essay 250-350 words in length, explaining your qualifications
- ★ Two letters of recommendation from persons not related to you
 - One letter must be from one of your high school, homeschool, or college teacher, mentor or professors
 - One letter must be from a community member
- ★ An official copy of your high school or college transcripts
- ★ This eligibility sheet
- ★ Your contact information

In the essay, explain your high school achievements, and your educational and professional goals. Include the school you would like to attend and the fields you would like to study.

We, as a service organization, are particularly interested in hearing about the contributions you have made to your community. In the essay, please describe any community service you may have participated in and explain how this experience might help you to complete your goals.

If you are awarded a 2026 Cambridge Commercial Club scholarship, funds will be payable to you in full upon the CCC Scholarship Committees receipt of your 2026 fall semester college transcript. You must use the scholarship during the ensuing academic year or submit a written request to defer it, giving reason for the deferment. The deadline to submit your deferral request or submit your Fall transcripts is January 31, 2027. Max deferment is 2 years. Not adhering to this deadline will result in a forfeit of your scholarship.
